ACTION REQUESTED

Ratification by the Board of Education of President of Board’s appointment of Jeffrey Hall to the Audit Committee, effective October 7, 2022, for unexpired term ending January 31, 2024.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The duties of the Audit Committee, as defined by Board Bylaw 9131, is to recommend to Board selection of independent auditors, review and advised Board of Education on all audit findings regarding District Budget, Parcel Taxes and General Obligation Bonds, adequacy of financial controls, concerns and perform other duties enumerated in said Bylaw.

The Audit Committee is composed of seven members, with staggered terms, appointed pursuant to membership criteria established by Board Bylaw 9131, with an individual's terms of appointment limited to a maximum of three two-year consecutive terms or the fulfillment of unexpired terms thereof.

The appointment of Mr. Hall will bring the Committee to five-sevenths of its membership.

I, pursuant to Board Bylaw 9131, hereby nominate Jeffrey Hall, as a member of Audit Committee, and recommend Board ratification of her appointment.
