PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The living schoolyard project is a collaboration between OUSD's Facilities Department and Trust for Public Land (TPL). The project includes landscaping upgrades, a new turf field, and a shade structure. Division of State Architect is requiring accessibility upgrades, which include a new ramp to the lower yard, minor restroom modifications, new handrails, and a new ramp in the rear of the school. Construction will take place from Summer 2022 through the Summer of 2023.

- Trust for public land has contracted with Botham construction.
- Bothman is mobilizing to begin work second week of school.
 Completion is estimated at the end of October.
- The district will re-bid the ADA updates portion of the work in Spring 2023 for construction in summer 2023.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Perkins-Eastman Architects completed the Project Definition phase in June 2022, this was developed by the architect through a series of community engagements with stakeholders including parents, students, staff, community partners, site leadership, and the Project Advisory Committee (PAC).

CURRENT ACTIVITIES

- After monthly committee meetings, meetings with students, teachers and two public meetings, a draft concept has been presented to facilities leadership, Mcclymonds site administration, staff, and the project committee.
- Perkins Eastman is now working on the final bridging documents which will be the basis of an RFQ/RFP that will be sent out in Fall 2022 to select the design-build entity that will complete the final design and construct the project.
- Geotechnical testing has completed sampling this summer, awaiting the final geotechnical report needed as a part of the aforementioned RFP-O.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project scope includes the demolition and replacement of the existing CDC structure. The new CDC consists of four preschool classrooms with the capacity to house 108 children. The front office includes a reception area, principal's office, a parent resource center, staff workroom, warming kitchen, restrooms, and utility support spaces.

Classroom design includes high ceilings to capture natural lighting above the reading circle. The playground includes a tricycle path, water play, nature play, art play, music play, garden, and artificial turf field.

- Saw cutting asphalt and tree removal and rough grading starts on 8/8.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project includes replacement of the outdoor athletic field, track, specialty athletic sport areas, and bleachers. Existing restroom facilities will be upgraded and new single-occupancy accessible restroom facilities will be added to new north and south plazas. This project includes ten accessible parking spaces and an accessible path of travel from the bust stop to the new work.

CURRENT ACTIVITIES

- NTP was issued and contractor mobilized on site on 07/20.
- Demolition has started on the site flatwork and stadium bleachers. Lumber from the stadium bleachers is being donated to a local nonprofit, Planting Justice, to be reused as planter beds in their nursery's and exterior siding for their sheds.
- The next few weeks will involve demolition of the interior of the restroom, stadium bleachers (abatement demo), site flatwork, and site utilities.
- Rough grading is expected to start towards the end of the month (August).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This new 56,176 S.F. two-story Administration building will house Oakland Unified School District (OUSD) Central Office Staff. Site improvements include landscaping, fences, parking lots, and driveways on the 2.6-acre site.

Existing structures to be demolished include a single-story 6,400 S.F. building, a two-story 44,999 S.F. building, and a single-story portable building. Demolition will be phased as the main building is currently occupied.

The Board approved the modification of the existing drawings to only build out the 2nd floor of the 2-story building. The multi-purpose building was also deleted.

CURRENT ACTIVITIES

- DTSC Work Notice issued for site work.
- Structural steel procurement and material identification is ongoing at the steel subcontractor facility.
- Approved PG&E drawings were received and bid. Offsite permit applied for with the City of Oakland.
- After-hours site security will continue for the duration of the project.
- Additional lighting has been added to the site.



Measures B, J & Y are local bond measures that fund the repair, renovation, and upgrading of Oakland Unified School District facilities, and improve local transportation in Alameda County.

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PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Construction of a new single story 9,544 sf steel frame multipurpose building, which includes cafeteria, kitchen, stage platform, restrooms, and associated support storage rooms; replacement of campus-wide intrusion alarm system; installation of full-height permanent walls at classrooms 4/5, 6/7, and 9/10; reconfiguration of existing restrooms into a new ADA single use restroom; modifications to the existing interior ramp.

CURRENT ACTIVITIES

- Existing Building A work complete permanent walls, door hardware installed in classrooms, new ADA single use restroom and ADA hallway ramp work completed.
- Surrounding site work, underground utility installation at building pad ongoing, preparations for footing excavations.
- Campus construction fencing installed.
