Giving Thanks to Director Aimee Eng for her Service to the Students and Staff of OUSD

WHEREAS, Director Eng has served as District 2 School Board Director for Oakland Unified School District for eight years, after being first elected in 2014. During that time, she was elected by her colleagues as President of the Board for a one year term on January 8, 2018; and re-elected January 7, 2019, for an additional one year term;

WHEREAS, Director Eng is a native Oaklander, in a family who has been here for six generations. Her parents are educators, and her grandfather Raymond Eng was Oakland's first Chinese-American City Council member elected in 1967;

WHEREAS, Director Eng has served as the Board's Chair of the Budget and Finance Committee, Board Liaison to the Bond Oversight Committee, and as a member of both the Citizens Advisory Committee on Special Education, and the City of Oakland's Education Partnership Committee;

WHEREAS, Director Eng helped lead the District through a variety of challenges including budget problems, funding issues for sports, the controversy surrounding police in schools after the death of George Floyd, labor issues, changes in leadership at the top of the District with the installment of Superintendent Kyla Johnson-Trammell, and the COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, Director Eng led the push, along with former Student Director Jessica Ramos, to create a mental health resolution - after a robust listening campaign - which allocated millions of dollars to support the mental health of students and staff starting during the time of the COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, Director Eng has been a fierce advocate for Measure N - and more recently Measure H - a parcel tax that created the College & Career For All Fund, which spread linked learning pathways to high schools across the District to provide real-world work and learning opportunities in fields including engineering, health care, media arts, and law. The effort has raised graduation rates, cut drop out rates, and improved A-G completion rates enabling more students to head straight to University of California and California State University schools;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that we recognize and celebrate Director Aimee Eng's service and steadfast commitment to all students, staff, and families of Oakland Unified School District. We wish her the very best in her future endeavors.

WHEREAS, President Dr. Gary Yee is closing out his most recent term as School Board Director (2019-2023) for the Oakland Unified School District (OUSD), representing District 4, and having been elected Board President on January 3, 2022, for a one year term;

WHEREAS, President Yee previously served ten years as School Board Director (2002-2013) during which time he served as President of the Board for two terms. In 2013, with the sudden departure of the Superintendent, Director Yee was also appointed by the Board as Interim Superintendent for the 2013-14 school year;

WHEREAS, President Yee, who is a life-long Oakland resident and a graduate of Castlemont High School, has served as a public-school educator and champion for young people in OUSD since 1973 in various roles including elementary teacher, assistant principal, principal, and district administrator;

WHEREAS, President Yee has been a vocal advocate for Measure H - a parcel tax that continued the College & Career For All Fund, which spread linked learning pathways to high schools across the District to provide real-world work and learning opportunities in fields including engineering, health care, media arts, and law. WHEREAS, President Yee celebrates the Board helping the District to finally pay off the state loan that resulted from receivership starting two decades ago, which the latest budget included, removing a weight from the shoulders of the District and helping it move on from a turbulent time in OUSD history;

WHEREAS, President Yee is an OUSD Board Representative to the California School Board Association (CSBA) and to the Council of Great City Schools (CGCS), in addition to the California Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development (CASCD). He was elected as a founding board member for the Linked Learning Alliance;

WHEREAS, Director Mungia was appointed to serve as District 6 School Board Director for Oakland Unified School District in June 2022. During the time since, she worked passionately for educational and racial equity for all students in OUSD;
