Background Since July 1994, the Commission on Teacher Credentialing has had the authority to issue waiver documents that have expressly to do with educator preparation and credentialing and with the ability of employers to employ or assign persons who are not appropriately credentialed for their assignment. All other waivers are under the legal authority of the State Board of Education or the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

A Waiver is issued or denied based upon the Commission’s established criteria and factors such as an employer’s continuing needs; the support the employer will provide to the applicant; or extenuating, extraordinary and unanticipated circumstances.

When an employing agency reviews its staffing needs and starts recruiting for various positions, all attempts must be made to fill a position with an appropriately credentialed employee. Employing agencies are required to first recruit a candidate who is qualified to participate in and enrolls in an approved internship program in the region of the employing agency and secondly, a candidate who is scheduled to complete preliminary credential requirements within six months.

If a fully credentialed candidate is not available employing agencies must recruit candidates in this order:

- A candidate who is scheduled to complete his or her preliminary credential requirements within six months
- A candidate who is qualified to participate and to enroll in an internship program
- A candidate who qualifies to use a local assignment option
- A candidate who qualifies for the Provisional Internship Permit (PIP) or the Short Term Staff Permit (STSP)

If the employer is unable to find an individual who qualifies for one of the staffing options listed above, the Variable Term Waiver may be requested for the most qualified candidate.

Discussion

1. Aimee Romo is requesting a Variable Term BCLAD Waiver: Spanish. Aimee graduated from California State University at East Bay with a Bachelor's in Human Development. This waiver will allow candidate time to complete CSET Exams required for a Full Bilingual Authorization: Spanish.
2. Riyadh Murshed is requesting a Variable Term CBEST Waiver: Education Specialist Mild/Moderate. He graduated from San Jose State University with a Bachelor's in Health Sciences. This waiver will grant candidate time to complete the CBEST, CSET and requirements for a University Intern Education Specialist: Mild/Moderate program.
3. Xazier McDougald is requesting a Variable Term CBEST Waiver. He graduated from Winston-Salem State University with a Bachelor's in English. This waiver will give candidate

time to complete the CBEST exams and the requirements for a University Single Subject Intern Program.

4. Felicia Yamaguchi is requesting a Variable Term CBEST Waiver. Felicia graduated from U.C. Berkeley with a Bachelor's degree in Ethnic Studies. This waiver will allow candidate time to complete the CBEST exam and the requirements for a University Single Subject Intern Program.
5. Erin Adachi-Kriege is requesting a Variable Term 30 Day Sub Waiver. Erin graduated from California State University at East Bay with a Bachelor's in Human Development. This waiver will grant candidate time to complete the CBEST exam and apply for an emergency 30 day sub permit.
6. MaggieAnn Scott is requesting a Variable Term Program Waiver. MaggieAnn graduated from Indiana Wesleyan University with a Masters degree in School Counseling. MaggieAnn is currently enrolled in a PPSC program. This waiver will allow candidate time to complete the program and earn her full Pupil Personnel Services Credential, School Counseling.
