



Restart Model

- Focus on Underperforming School in West Oakland
- Rocketship Education operate a school with a charter approved and authorized by the Oakland Unified School District to open in August of 2013
- Rocketship provide preference to students of existing school in lottery and during 'restart'
- Rocketship granted a lease to the school facilities utilizing a long-term lease with fair, market rates
