Title: Ratification by the Board of Education of a Professional Services Contract between District and We

Lead Ours, for the latter to provide 166 hours each at both Bret Harte and Street Academy school sites, to recruit 10-15 peer educators, representative of schools ethnicities and identified as being natural leaders; train students on assessing tobacco and marijuana use on campus and among student body; train students on the science of inquiry and developing measures to address the schools prevention needs; train students on leadership; collaborative environment, youth/adult partnerships; presentation skills; educate students on developing media and activities to educate their peers in classrooms and assemblies; facilitate 10 to 15 anti-tobacco/marijuana presentations and two schoolwide prevention education campaigns to reach all students at the school site; train students to administer classroom presentation evaluations; train students on evaluating their own work and provide positive feedback to their working groups; and train students to help their peers at risk to access student services at their site and their community, for the period of November 7, 2012 through

June 7, 2013, in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00.
