
ACC WORK/ OYV Update

What is the Oakland Youth Vote?

- A campaign and Measure Passed in November 2020 that Expanded voting rights to 16-and-17-year-olds in School Board Elections
- It is an effort to build power for young people to as a constituency and as the primary recipients of decisions made by the Oakland Unified School Board





OAKLAND YOUTH VOTE / MEASURE QQ CAMPAIGN HISTORY



→ PHASE 1: GETTING IT ON THE BALLOT

- ◆ After enormous efforts by the coalition and community members the Oakland City Council voted unanimously to put Oakland Youth Vote on the November 2020 ballot.

→ PHASE 2: GATHERING SUPPORT (GOTV)

- ◆ For months, the Oakland student leaders and the Oakland Youth Vote coalition gathered support for Measure QQ (OYV) through social media efforts, events, and phone banking!
- ◆ On November 3rd 2020 Measure QQ passed by 67.88% (131K + Votes)!

→ PHASE 3: IMPLEMENTATION

- ◆ Currently in the process of implementing OYV

IMPLEMENTATION

VOTER REGISTRATION:

Coordinate efforts to register and pre-register thousands of youth voters prior to the 2022 elections

IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGY / Taskforce:


Work with City Council and City Attorneys, OUSD, and Voter Registrar's Office to determine logistics such as: polling places, pre-registering younger voters, special ballots, etc.

VOTER EDUCATION:

Help with curriculum development, classroom presentations, focus groups, etc. in efforts to mobilize young voters.

YOUTH PLATFORM:

Engage a critical mass of students across Oakland Schools to identify and lift core issues impacting Oakland Students and develop non-negotiable demands for OUSD.


