 - 0 Frog Street















Summary Data for March 2022

- I chose CC because the assessment and learning continuum can be a big step up from how students are testeed and monitored.
- Freedom helps instructors choose what to teach based on student needs.
- The curriculum creates the space to start working towards the classroom environments we truly want.


