Katy Zaugg shared the proposed spending of the Measure G1 carry over funds. Ms Zaugg explained the what the parcel is and how the money can be used.

The proposal is for the carry over funds \$10,354.80 to be used to expand the middle school access program to have an additional class focused on vocal music.

Parent question: What are the access courses?

Answer: program for students in grades 6-8 to take a weekly elective outside their subpathway.

Parent question: What are these courses?

Answer: description of current classes and durations (various and semester long)

Ms Zaugg explains the number of classes and high interest. The larger class sizes and wait list for the sole vocal class is justification to add that course.

Parent question: Would this start next semester?

Answer: This would be for 23-24. As courses are set for 22-23.

Parent questions: What other things we could spend on?

Answer: Review of Measure G parameters and how current Measure G funds are used. The instruments for students in the instrumental department, a small portion of part time counselor's fte to have created and continue to hold middle school specific support group for students exploring gender identity and curriculum for students 6-8th focused on healthy relationships and consent education.

Parent question: Why vocal?

Answer: That is a large department and currently has just one offering- there is requests to have more classes for non vocal students interested in switched to that subpwathy (potentially) for HS.
