- Lowest Bid is from a known contractor who has done business with the district.
- Lowest Bid was approx. \$1.75M below next lowest bid.
- Likely cause of low bid is efficiencies of working on multiple projects with in the district.










### **Current Inflation Rates**



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








# **Transportation Costs**
