






GOAL 1: Decrease High School Dropout Rate



OUSD: 12.5% 1.7 percentage point decrease since 2018-19


Dropout rate for Latinx students decreased from 23.2% in 2018-19 to 18.9% in 2019-20



Charter School Average: 5.3% 0.5 percentage point increase since 2018-19




GOAL 2: Increase High School Graduation Rate

Graduation rate for Latinx students increased from 61.3% in 2018-19 to 64.7% in 2019-20





GOAL 4: Increase Middle School Students' Successful Transition to High School



Latinx students who graduated and met A-G requirements **increased** from 49.3% in 2018-19 to 51.5% in 2019-20


