


### **Overview - Probationary Process**

Board Recommendations	Board recommends probationary schools get more intensive supports to implement strategies that support Linked Learning before funding is reduced	
Consultations	Sites are provided consultation with staff to review feedback and get an overview of probationary process and expectations	
Capacity Building	Sites are required to hire a Linked Learning coach.	
Site Visits and Feedback	Site visits include meetings with students, teachers, administrative teams, and classroom observations.	
Final Presentation	Schools submit progress update to Measure N Commision and answer key questions regarding their progress and plans for next year.	

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

Probationary Full Implementation \$850	<ul> <li>School has clear and consistent vision for the pathway theme and program design since the inception of probationary status</li> <li>School has operationalized the Linked Learning elements including work based learning and career technical education with a building career technical education sequence of 2 or more courses.</li> <li>School is striving to continuously improve the overall quality of the student's Linked Learning experience</li> <li>Funding is aligned to integrate both college and career readiness</li> </ul>					
Probationary Planning & Piloting \$525	<ul> <li>The school's vision and focus has developed some coherence during the probationary phase of the grant</li> <li>School has some elements of Linked Learning solidly built out, but are still piloting other ideas aligned to Linked Learning Pathway Development</li> <li>Does not have a comprehensive view of how career technical education is integrated into the school or is still learning about how to implement Linked Learning instructionally</li> </ul>					
Probationary Planning \$200	<ul> <li>School has consistently shifted focus or theme during the life of the funding and lacks coherence</li> <li>Funding is not directly aligned to support the build out the 4 elements of Linked Learning and may be using funding to supplant</li> <li>The school did not directly address the feedback that was provided by staff during the process or missed key milestones and meetings</li> <li>There is significant implementation risk based off a lack of staff awareness and buy-in of the school direction</li> <li>Does not have a comprehensive view of how career technical education is integrated into the school and has an overall focus solely on college readiness</li> </ul>

#### Ralph J. Bunche Academy

Bunche was first recommended for probationary status at the end of the 2019-20 academic year.

Probationary status was recommended due to the following feedback:

- Need to work on expanding pathway to meet goals for student engagement
- Continue root cause analysis by disaggregating data and diving deeper into student motivation and engagement
- Continue to develop and refine goals and strategic actions specific to development and growth of Linked Learning
- Continue cultivating programs on recruitment

#### Year 2 Probationary Status December 2021 Assessment

- IP Work on expanding pathway to meet goals for student engagement
- NA Continue root cause analysis
