April 2023 EIP Presentation Guidance

Overview: We are looking forward to your EIP presentations to the Measure N Commission in April. Please take a moment to review this guidance so that you and your team are prepared and know what to expect.

Note: This year the presentations will take place IN PERSON at **La Escuelita Elementary School (1050 2nd Avenue)** in the **Committee Room**. Please plan for sufficient commute time and arrive 10 minutes before your scheduled time.

Objective: The Measure N Commissioners have an earnest desire to support the success of pathways. The presentations provide an opportunity for the Commissioners to systematically learn about the work of all our funded schools, with a primary goal of supporting student success.

Schedule: The EIP presentations will take place during the weeks of **April 10th** and **April 17th**. We are in the process of finalizing the schedule; you can view the schedule here. You will receive a calendar invite from Stacey once your presentation time is confirmed.

Presenters: Please plan to assemble a small team of individuals to speak that includes the following:

- Principal
- The Commission would like to hear from staff at the school who are doing the Pathway work, not just the Principal. Bring people from your school site team who can:
 - a. Speak to the components of Linked Learning
 - Integrated Program of Study
 - Work-Based Learning
 - Integrated Student Supports
 - b. Answer the below questions
- The Commission strongly recommends that a student and family member be a part of your team; they do not have to speak as part of the presentation but would be able to respond to questions from the Commission.

Content and Timing: Comprehensive high schools will have a **40-minute session** (*Oakland High, Tech, Skyline, Castlemont, Fremont, McClymonds*). All other schools, including Charters, will have a **30-minute session**. Each school should be prepared to provide the following:

- Introduction of Presenters and Overview of School's Pathway(s) (5 minutes)
- School Site team provides answers to the below questions: (25 minutes for comprehensive schools, 15 minutes for all other schools)

1. Reflections on Past 3 Years

- a. What are you most proud of in terms of pathway development?
- b. What have been some of the challenges?
- c. What have been your biggest learnings?

2. Looking Ahead

- a. What have you learned through creating this new plan for the next 3-year cycle?
- b. What are you most excited about?
- c. What are your biggest challenges moving forward?
- How are your Pathway(s) helping to close equity gaps in your school?
 (through the lens of your site's LCAP focal groups.)
- Optional: It is optional to create a PowerPoint slide deck for your presentation. If you would like to do so, here is a <u>slide deck template</u> for your use. Please note if you choose to do a PowerPoint, you will need to submit it to Stacey by March 22nd.
- Optional: You may choose to include as part of your presentation a short, (no more than 2 minutes) informal video where students, teachers or family members respond to a specific question (such as how has participating in your pathway influenced your college and career goals?). The video must be submitted to Stacey by March 22nd.
- **Q&A:** For the remainder of your presentation time, the Commission will engage in a question and answer session with your site team. (10 minutes)
- **Note:** You do not need to show your site's 4 Pillars document(s) as part of your presentation, but be prepared to talk through the document if requested.
