[SB 492 \(Menjivar\)](#) Youth Housing Bond Act 2026

Recommended Position: **Support**

Summary: Puts the Youth Housing Bond Act of 2026 on the ballot of the next statewide general election. If approved by voters, the Act would authorize the sale of \$1 billion of general obligations bonds for purposes of funding youth housing programs.

Background Today, this is the second round of recommended bill position(s), after analysis by the Board's Ad Hoc Intergovernmental Relations Committee. The recommendation is aligned with the adopted platform. Housing for youth provides safety, security and school attendance.
