Schoolwide Data**

College Enrollment

Class of 2017 (40 graduates):

- 63% 4-year college
- 15% 2-year college
- 2% Vocational Training
- 20% Working, Not Enrolled, & Other

Class of 2018 Snapshot Responses (70 graduates):

- 61% 4-year college
- 13% 2-year college
- 6% Vocational Training
- 20% Working, Not Enrolled, & Other

Graduation Rate

2014-2015 Graduation Rate: 83% (According to WASC Report)

2015-2016 Graduation Rate: 80% (According to WASC Report)

2016-2017 Graduation Rate: Still being finalized by California Dept. of Ed--estimated to be between 80-85%

Note:

- 100% of our graduates meet UC/CSU Entrance Requirements (According to WASC Report)

On-Track/Off-Track Grade 10

As of February 2018:

- 62% of our 92 10th graders are on track to graduate with 240 credits in 4-years
- 11% are within 10 credits of being on track
- 18% have less than 60 credits accrued

NOTE: On Track = Accumulated 90 Academic Credits

On-Track/Off-Track Grade 11

As of February 2018:

- 89% of our 69 11th graders are on track to graduate with 240 credits in 4-years
- 4% are within 10 credits of being on track

NOTE: On Track = Accumulated 150 Academic Credits

Pathway Enrollment

100% of our 9th Grade Class is enrolled in our Linked Learning Pathway. They have all learned about the four pillars and seen integrated projects in Algebra 1 & Biology.

By the end of the year they will have seen entrepreneurship integrated into ALL of their core classes and be able to articulate how the work of their 9th grade year will be continued in 10th Grade.

For 10-12th graders, we have piloted nearly a dozen different projects and opportunities. Most significantly, we have refined our 10th Grade EOY Exhibition to incorporate the pillars of Linked Learning & built out an Internship Pilot for a small section of our 11th and 12th grade classes.
