Part 2: Proposed Strategies to Increase Savings. [60 minutes]

- o Staff presents reports to gain better understanding of how unrestricted general fund dollars are currently being used within Infrastructure, Supporting Schools, and School;
- o Staff presents steps that are being taken to address above issues including opportunities for cost savings and expenditure reductions and current thinking on recommendations (if available)
- o Committee presents recommended areas for further study and analysis for costs savings to consider including Book and Supplies, Professional and Consulting Services, Certificated Supervisors and Administrators, and Classified

Supervisors and Administrators (see pages 2-3 in Budget Revision attached document)

Desired Outcome: Identify strategies to increase savings in 17-18 year to meet fiscal solvency objectives.
