PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Fremont High School New School Construction includes:

Increment 1: New school entry and parking lot.

Increment 2: New 2-story Pre-Fabricated 12 classroom building.

Increment 3: Renovating existing building (Building B) to house spaces for Career Technical Education pathways.

Increment 4: Extension of new parking lot. New regulated football field, gymnasium with wellness center inside.

UPDATE

Construction - Increment 2. New 2-story Building

2-way communication install is nearly complete and will be ready for final inspection soon. Pathway has been provided to safely enter Frog bldg. while Inc. 3 site work begins. 11-month warrant walks have begun.

Construction - Increment 3. Building B Renovation

Interior painting on-going. Flooring install has begun. Storefront windows install continues. Casework install in science lab has begun. Landscaping and site work has begun. Above ceiling mechanical and electrical rough-in continues.

Construction - Increment 4. Gymnasium, Football Stadium and Wellness Clinic

Field work continues. Home and visitor bleacher install continues along with the press box. Interior painting and flooring continues. Metal panel install at high roof continues. Ygnacio sidewalk work is nearing completion.
