Subject 2025-26 School Safety Update

Ask of the Board Review and provide feedback on the Safety Update presented by staff.

Background Each year, the Board receives an update on the safety improvements of the District. This update is meant to provide an overview of Safety in OUSD, a review of key data, progress information regarding the intended improvements, and a description of the on-going work to improve safety in our District.

Discussion School safety remains a critical priority for OUSD and continues to evolve through the District's commitment to the George Floyd Resolution. Over the past several years, OUSD has worked to develop and strengthen alternative safety systems that reduce reliance on law enforcement while increasing access to behavioral health, restorative, and crisis response resources.

This update provides an overview of the District's school safety framework, including the guiding principles that shape our work, the development of safety infrastructure and response systems, and data reflecting implementation progress. Additionally, highlighting our investments in Village Response Teams, Culture Keepers, Culture & Climate Ambassadors, staff training, behavioral health partnerships, and centralized crisis support resources.

The Board will also receive information regarding incident response trends, police activity data, progress on 2025-26 safety priorities, and emerging priorities for the 2026-27 school year. Together, these efforts reflect OUSD's ongoing commitment to creating safe, supportive, and inclusive learning environments for all students and staff.
