DISCOVERY & ISSUES

Establish Roles

- Identify representatives from task force partner groups.
- Review and confirm project definitions and goals.
- Define scope and boundaries in relation to other initiatives: "What is the project at hand?"
- Identify other community stakeholders to engage.

Collect Data

- Audit existing programs and services in each regional zone. (capacity/target pop)
- Collect OUSD facility information
- Review programs that operate in or use school facilities
- Identify demographics of populations served and types of services offered in each zone.
- Identify missing or incomplete data that must be collected.
- Identify partnerships that could be leveraged acquire missing data.
- Map assets and facilities in each region.

Outcome/ Deliverables Task force composed, data assembled.

ASSESSMENT

Program Capacity

- Evaluate whether programs and services provided are appropriate to meet demand.
- Assess overutilization or underutilization of programs and services within each zone.
- Evaluate whether space and facility conditions meet the needs of service delivery.
- Determine if programs and services are adequately staffed to meet demand.

Opportunities & Challenges

- Assess location and schedule of program and service delivery. Are locations and times aligned with neighborhood needs?
- Identify places where existing programs and services can be maximized through consolidation within or across zones.
- Identify geographic, economic, and political challenges to changes.
- Review best practices where services and program distribution systems best meet community needs.

STRATEGY

Gap Identification

- Identify gaps in community assets as they relate to need.
- Identify gaps in regional programs and services.

Governance Process

- Define new organizational processes.
- Align regional vision with neighborhood cultural identities.

Planning Strategy

- Rightsize community assets and spaces.
- Develop planning alternatives to address gaps in program and service provision.
- Align facility strategies with planning alternatives.
- Document standards and develop prototypes for programs and services at the regional scale.
- Model Planning Scenarios

PLANNING & DESIGN

Specific Content

- Develop processes and procedures for neighborhood zone activities.
- Develop planning and design concepts.
- Establish what equipment, supplies, and materials are required to execute planning alternatives.
- Align technology to meet new procedures of regional structure and distribution of programs and services.

Access and Communication

- Utilize existing communication methods to disseminate information.
 Adjust where needed.
- Ensure access and security for community users in new programs and services.
- Share information with community and solicit feedback.

PROTOTYPE &

Partnerships

- Meet with community to verify that prototype plans meet the needs of the users.
- Ensure that partnerships within and across zones function effectively to meet the program and service needs of each neighborhood zone.
- Verify changes in spaces meet the needs of users and adjust where necessary.
- Evaluate critical adjacencies and their impact on program and service delivery.

Measurement

- Assess costs and benefits of revenue generating program ideas and costcutting consolidations.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of zone-based activities based on established performance metrics.

IMPLEMENTATION

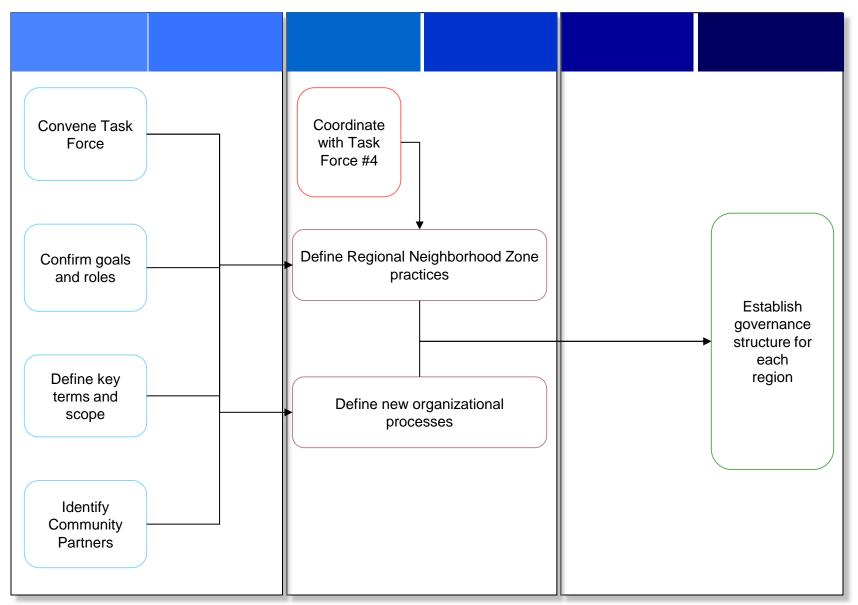
Execute Plan

- Evaluate performance metrics for each neighborhood zone.

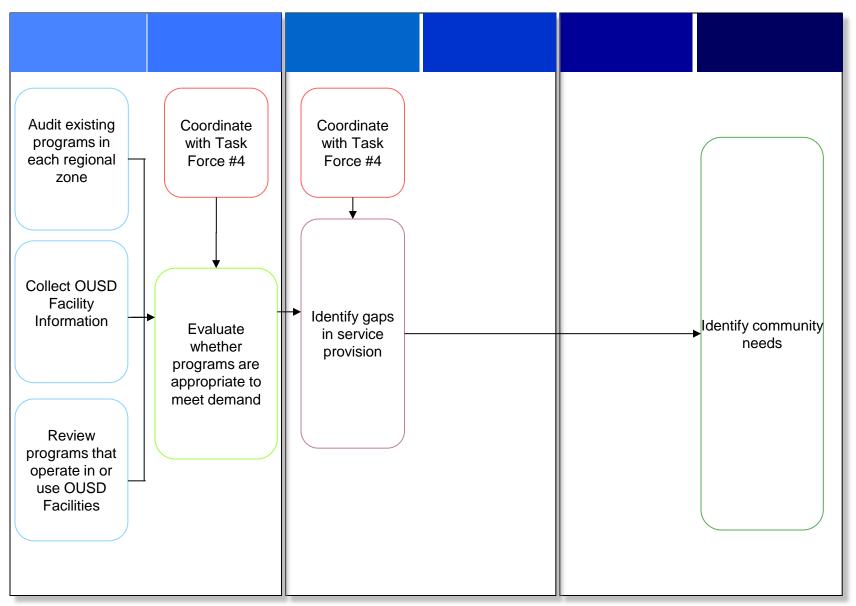

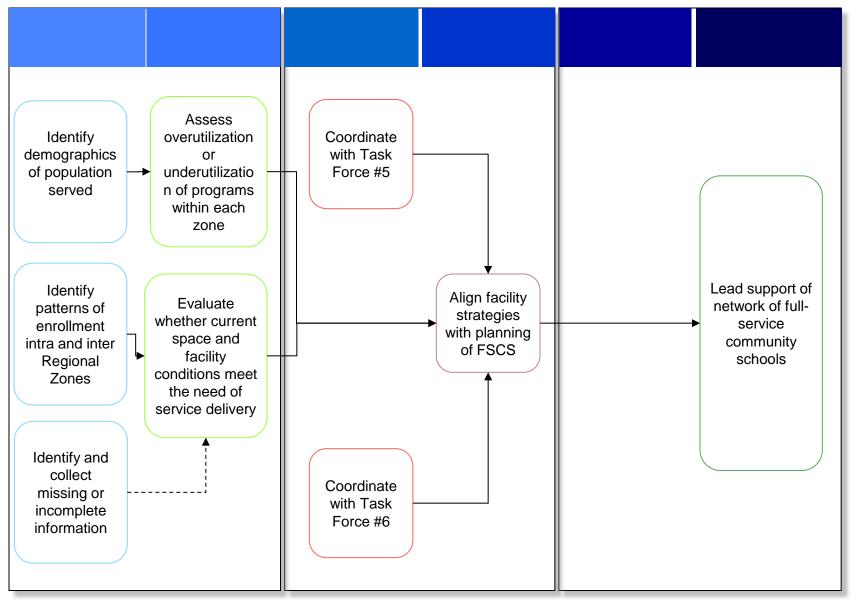
Establish Governance Structure



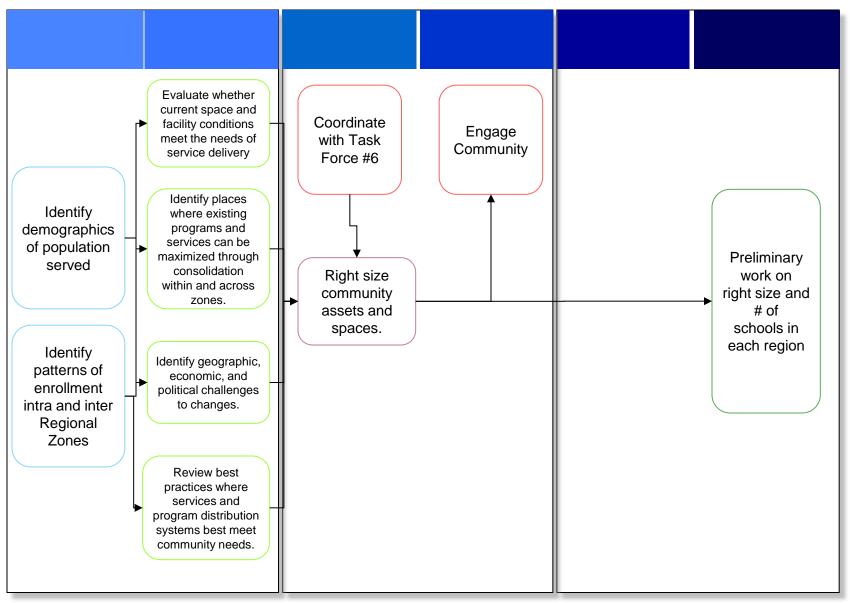
Identify Community Needs



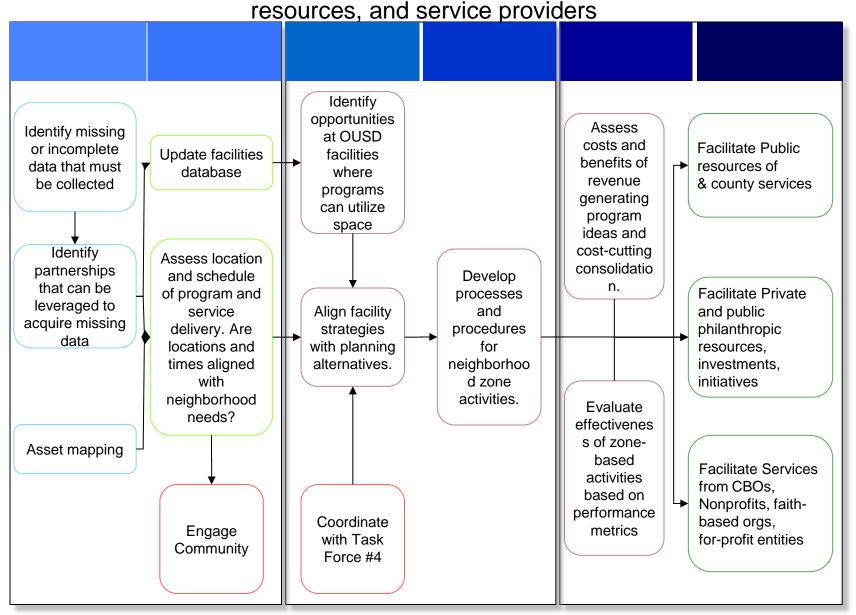
Lead Support Network of Full-Service Community Schools



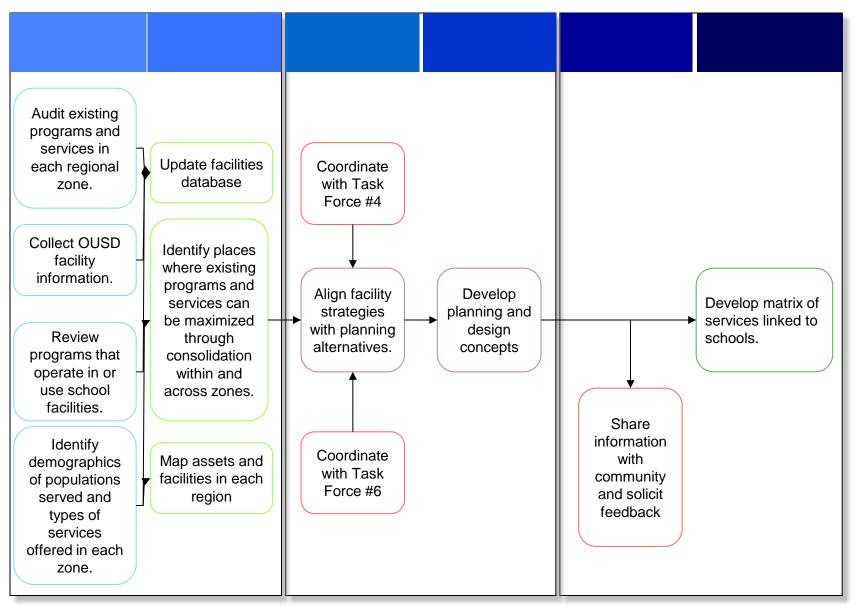
Right Size and Number of Schools



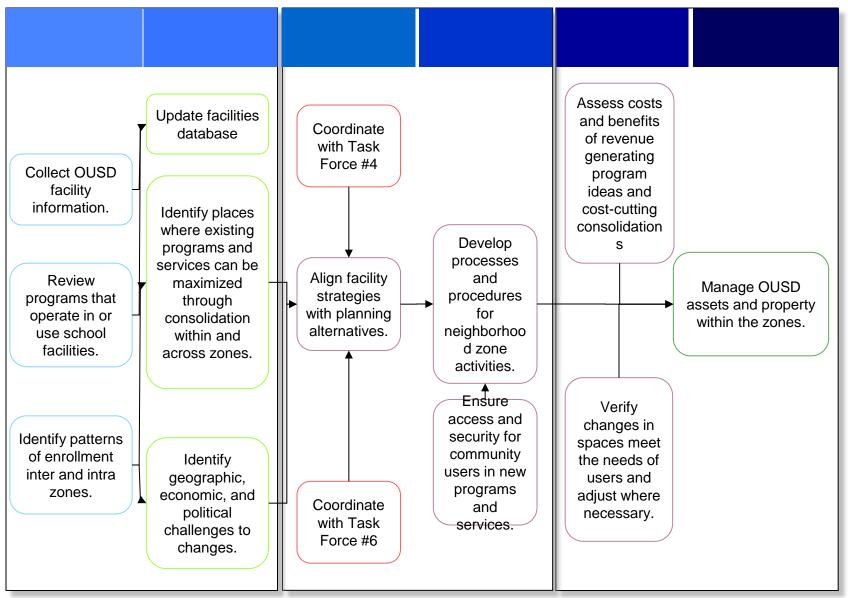
