WHEREAS, under the visionary leadership of Principal Sambrani, Lincoln Elementary has implemented research-based, coherent PK–5 curriculum aligned with district priorities, ensuring that instruction is rigorous, culturally responsive, and designed to close achievement gaps; and,

WHEREAS, Lincoln Elementary School serves a diverse population of approximately 700 students, including 54 percent English learners, and is committed to creating an inclusive, welcoming environment where every child can thrive; and,

WHEREAS, the school's strong family and community collaborations, coupled with data-driven instructional practices and targeted student supports, have propelled Lincoln Elementary to rank among the top performing elementary schools in Oakland Unified School District; and,

WHEREAS, The California Distinguished Schools program recognizes schools based on performance and progress on the state indicators including test scores, suspension rates, and conditions and climate. Elementary schools and middle and high schools are recognized in alternate years, therefore, awardees hold the title for two years,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Oakland Unified School District, and Dr. Kyla Johnson-Trammell, Superintendent of Schools, acknowledges and honors Lincoln Elementary for outstanding service to the students of Oakland.
