OUSD Skilled Trades 2016-2017



1. Establish and fund a Summer Pre-apprenticeship Internship Program and a 3-year School Year Pre-Apprenticeship Program for at least thirty (30) students.

Annually, for the 2016-17, 2017-18 and 2018-19, \$60,000 shall allocated for the Summer Pre-apprenticeship Internship program. No later than October 30 of each year, the Superintendent shall report to the Board on the Summer Pre-Apprenticeship program and make recommendations for program changes that will improve the experience of students. ...

Funding was provided but program was still offered. Information on upcoming Slides.

3. Establish a Workforce Development Fund. The District will require that all contractors working under the Project Labor Agreement ("PLA") contribute \$.20 per work-hour performed under the PLA to a Workforce and Apprenticeship Development Fund administered by the District with the advice of the Joint Administration Committee of the PLA. No less than 80% of the Fund shall be used to fund direct work based learning programs and apprenticeships for Oakland students.

Org Key was established for collection of the funds.

2. The District shall, with the support of the Alameda County Building Trades Council, co-sponsor two Building & Construction Trades Career Fairs during each school year that provide exposure to Oakland students and families.

Skilled Trades Career Fairs were held in the Spring of 2017. Information on upcoming Slides

4. Establish an Industry Partnership Council specifically focused on the Building and Construction Trades to support the successful implementation of this program.

Initial meeting just took place this Fall.

California Apprenticeship Initiative Grant: Build out Pre-Apprentice Program at two high school sites.

Slightly under \$500,000 to be used July 2017 - January 2019. Funds are being used to create & support programs at Skyline High School (Green Academy) & Fremont High School (Architecture Academy)

Total Student Impact : 749+

Total Transportation Cost (OUSD): \$3,550

Total Transportation Cost (Partners): \$14,300

Summer Pre-Program Cost: \$25,000
