



# Successes & Challenges




**94%** Students who **completed A-G requirements** for UC admission

- 8 days of **Network PD**



# RTI

**Specialized mental health support** for students facing persistent and severe traumas and stresses

**Tier 3**

**8% of students**

Single referral to **integrated academic, behavior, and mental health support** - initial response within 48 hours and goal-centered 5-6 week cycles of intervention





# Creating a College-Going Culture




- **Freshman Retreat UC Santa Cruz**
