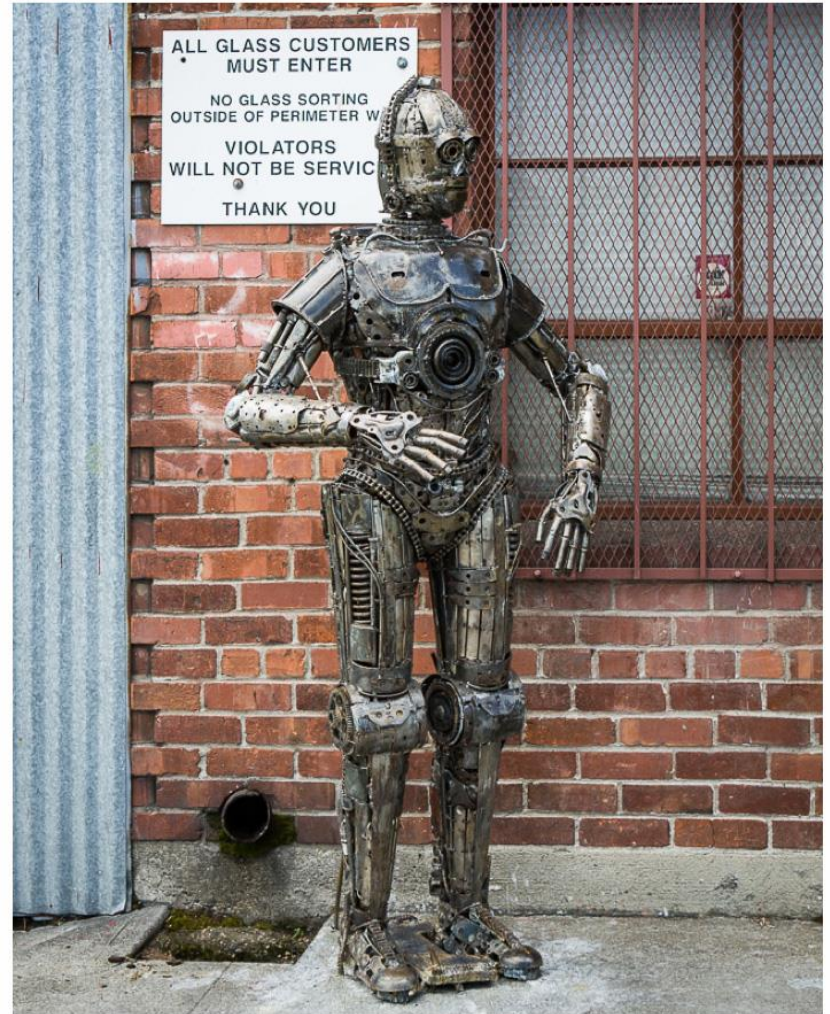

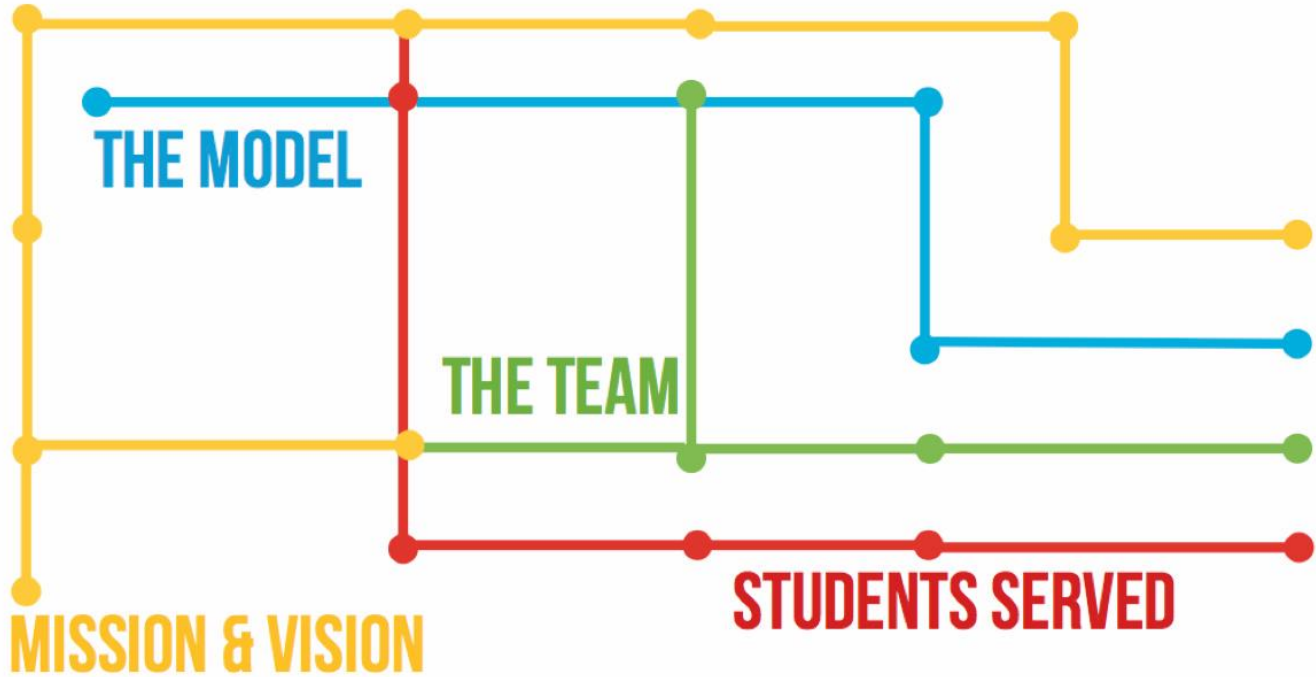


WHAT IS EBIA?

CORE MODEL ELEMENTS - ACADEMIC

1. STEM BASED

- Coding class
- Design class
- Rigorous math and science
- Maker time

2. RIGOROUS COURSE LOAD

- Graduation requirements exceed UC A-G requirements

3. PROJECT BASED LEARNING

- Community based, real world, collaborative, interdisciplinary, learning experiences.
- Digital portfolios

4. BLENDED LEARNING

- Personalized and differentiated
- Rotation model and self blend

CORE MODEL ELEMENTS - INDIVIDUAL

5. ADVISORY

- Every student paired with an educator
- Daily advisory support
- Personalized Learning Plans (PLP)

6. INTEGRATED CLASSROOMS

- Common intellectual mission for all students regardless of background
- Provided the same curriculum
- All expected to complete college

7. INTERSESSION

- 6-8 weeks of in-depth elective courses or internships
- Collaboration with community organizations and local businesses

8. SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING

- Proficient in SEL skills of self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship skills, and responsible decision making

CORE MODEL ELEMENTS - SUPPORTS

9. PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Intersession weeks provide significant time for PD, to plan lessons, analyze student work and data, and design student supports

10. DATA/COMPETENCY BASED

- Leader in collecting, analyzing, presenting and actioning student data
- Ability to optimize learning for all

11. SPECIAL EDUCATION

- Designed to meet the academic and behavioral needs of all students, including to those with learning differences and disabilities

12. ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS

- Accelerate acquisition of academic English
- Respect and value for culture and home language

FACTS AND FIGURES

EBIA plans to serve approximately 770 students in grades 6 - 12, with a full build-out in Year 8. In Year One we will enroll 150 students in grades 6, and 90 students in grades 7.

EBIA will work in partnership with OUSD to determine the best location for a magnet school that will draw students from across Oakland and that will meet the needs of our instructional model.
