Action Requested Approval by the Board of Education of Resolution No. 1415-0093
Authorization to Declare Obsolete Computer Related Equipment (Routers)
Surplus Property and Authorizing Sale as stated herein.

Background Since wireless access points and technologies have changed rapidly in recent years, the life cycle is shorter. Items were found to be surplus, obsolete and of no further use to the District. It is the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools that such items be declared surplus and sold in accordance with Education Code Sections 17545 and 17546, respectively.


