

This grant supports school sites to complete a root cause analysis that addresses the low literacy levels and to complete a focused improvement plan for their school sites. Upon successful completion of the root cause analysis and improvement plan, our schools will receive 3 years of financial support that varies depending on the number of students enrolled in the 3rd grade at each school identified by the California Department of Education (CDE).
How will this grant be evaluated for impact upon student achievement? (Customized data design and technical support are provided at 1% of the grant award or at a negotiated fee for a community-based fiscal agent who is not including OUSD's indirect rate of 5.56% in the budget. The 1% or negotiated data fee will be charged according to an Agreement for Grant Administration Related Services payment schedule. This fee should be included in the grant's budget for evaluation.) 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
