
The Measure N Commission has voted to engage in a Participatory Action Research project to learn about Measure N's impact.






## MEASURE N FUNDED ACTIVITIES | Creation of New & Expanded Career Pathways


3 NEW PATHWAYS ADDED; TOTAL OF 40 PATHWAYS



## PERCENTAGE OF ALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS IN LINKED LEARNING PATHWAYS




■ **PERCENTAGE OF 10TH GRADERS IN LINKED LEARNING PATHWAYS**




MEASURE N GOAL 1: DECREASE THE HIGH SCHOOL DROPOUT RATE


Drop out rates for African American students has decreased from 9.3% in 2017-18 to 7.8% in 2018-19


MEASURE N GOAL 2: INCREASE THE HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION RATE
