





- Deferred Maintenance (DM) is defined as repair and/or replacement of existing site improvements and infrastructure - major maintenance, replacements, and repairs on aging facilities.
- DM focuses on maintaining the lifecycle expectations and optimizing service life by application of an effective maintenance and replacement strategy.
- DM provides optimum longevity and prevents potential breakdown or malfunction of facilities, resulting in annual cost savings.
- Investing in the required maintenance infrastructure creates a safe learning environment, contributing significantly to student's academic success.
- Type of replacement or repair work included in Fiscal Year(FY) 2022-23:
 - o Plumbing, sewer
 - Heating systems
 - Air-conditioning
 - Electrical systems
 - o Roof
 - **Windows**
 - o Asphalt
 - o Boiler
 - o Flooring
 - Painting
- In February 2020, the Board approved a five- year annual \$7M Deferred Maintenance Budget. However, budget constraints lowered the amount to \$5M per year. The Board later reduced the funding to \$3M to provide budget solutions for the Blueprint Cohort 3 savings.
- In FY 2022-23, the Board approved \$3M to fund districtwide DM projects








