ACTION REQUESTED:

Conduct Public Hearing and Adoption of Resolution No. 0708-0231 - Request to the California State Board of Education for a General Waiver of California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 5 sections 862(c)(2)(A) and 11517.5(b)(1)(A) Pertaining to Assessment Apportionment Funds for STAR and CELDT Testing Regarding Pupils at Achieve Academy for Fiscal Year 2006-2007.

BACKGROUND:

California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 5 sections 862(c)(2)(A) and 11517.5(b)(1)(A) provide for unrestricted funds to reimburse school districts for costs associated with the STAR and CELDT test administration. In Fiscal Year 2006-2007, Education for Change ("EFC"), which operates Achieve Academy, a charter school authorized by the Oakland Unified School District ("The District") missed the deadline for the Apportionment Information Reporting for its STAR and CELDT tests because of staffing challenges. EFC, having missed this deadline, will not receive the funds associated with these assessments. EFC, pursuant to CCR Title 5 sections 862(c)(2)(B) and 11517.5(b)(1)(B), which allows local educational agencies to apply for waivers of the deadline through Education Code 33050 et seq., is seeking a waiver pursuant to the above cited sections in order to receive reimbursement for its administration of STAR and CELDT at Achieve Academy.

The District, as authorizer of Achieve Academy, pursuant to Education Code Section 33050, must submit this waiver request on behalf of the school. Staff recommends that the State Administrator, pursuant to CCR Title 5 sections 862(c)(2)(B) and 11517.5(b)(1)(B), and as documented herein, submit a Request for a General Waiver, which if granted, will allow Achieve Academy to receive Assessment Apportionment Funds for CELDT and STAR administration.

FISCAL IMPACT

The adoption of the Request by the District and granting of the Waiver by the State Board of Education will allow Achieve Academy to receive Assessment Apportionment Funds for STAR and CELDT testing, and will not have a negative fiscal impact on the District.

RECOMMENDATION:

Conduct Public Hearing and Adoption of Resolution No. 0708-0231 - Request to the California State Board of Education for a General Waiver of California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 5 sections 862(c)(2)(A) and 11517.5(b)(1)(A) Pertaining to Assessment Apportionment Funds for STAR and CELDT Testing Regarding Pupils at Achieve Academy for Fiscal Year 2006-2007.

WHEREAS, Education for Change ("EFC") operates Achieve Academy, a charter school authorized by the Oakland Unified School District ("The District"); and

WHEREAS, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 5 sections 862(c)(2)(A) and 11517.5(b)(1)(A) provide for unrestricted funds to reimburse school districts for costs associated with the STAR and CELDT tests; and

WHEREAS, Education for Change, in Fiscal Year 2006-2007, missed the deadline for the Apportionment Information Reporting for its STAR and CELDT tests because of staffing challenges; and

WHEREAS, Education for Change, having missed this deadline, will not receive the funds associated with these assessments; and

WHEREAS, CCR Title 5 sections 862(c)(2)(B) and 11517.5(b)(1)(B) allow local educational agencies to apply for waivers of the deadline through Education Code 33050 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, Education for Change is seeking a waiver pursuant to the above cited sections in order to receive reimbursement for its administration of STAR and CELDT; and

WHEREAS, Education Code sections 33050-33053 provide for the charter school authorizing entity to request that the California State Board of Education waive sections of the Education Code or implementing regulations on behalf of a charter school; and

WHEREAS, the request by the District for and granting of the Waiver by the State Board of Education will allow Achieve Academy to collect apportionment, which it would otherwise be denied; and

WHEREAS, the request by the District and granting of the Waiver by the State Board of Education will not have a negative fiscal impact on, or otherwise harm, the District; and

WHEREAS, at its July 8, 2008 meeting, the State Administrator held a public hearing on the General Waiver Request,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the State Administrator of the District hereby approves the District's Request for General Waiver of CCR, Title 5 sections 862(c)(2)(A) and 11517.5(b)(1)(A) on behalf of Achieve Academy, incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth, to the California State Board of Education and authorizes the submission of same with requisite supporting documentation.

Certification of Apportionment Information Report: The superintendent or charter school director and the CELDT District Coordinator are required to certify that the district has returned all secure test materials, certify the accuracy of the report, sign and date the report, and return it postmarked by December 31, 2007 to:

Please allow eight to ten weeks after December 31st for districts to receive warrants. Payments will be processed through the State Controller's Office to county treasurers. All certified apportionment information reports must be postmarked by December 31, 2007 to qualify for the eight to ten week-turnaround. If postmarked after December 31, the apportionment information report must be accompanied by the State Testing Apportionment Information Report Waiver request as provided by Education Code Section 33050. The waiver request is available at http://www.cde.ca.gov/re/lr/wr/documents/december31.doc. Information regarding the waiver form is available at http://www.cde.ca.gov/re/ir/wr/othertopics.asp. Questions regarding the State Testing Apportionment Information Report waiver should be directed to CDE Waivers Office at (916) 319-0824.

Apportionment Amounts: The CELDT 2006-07 apportionment is \$5.00 for each pupil tested in Kindergarten through grade 12. The CELDT apportionment funds are unrestricted funds to reimburse districts for costs associated with the CELDT that are above and beyond the CDE statewide contract with test contractors. The CDE contract with the test contractors covers the costs of all required CELDT testing materials, scoring, and report production.

Charter Schools: Charter schools that tested independent of their district will receive individual apportionment information reports to certify and return to CDE. District apportionment totals will include apportionment funding for dependent charters. The payment schedule provided to districts will include a listing of the amount dependent charters are each to be apportioned.

Corrections to Apportionment Information Report: Requests to CDE to change data as reported on the apportionment information report must be accompanied by documentation that the district notified CDE of data disputes in writing after receipt of test result summary reports and data files [per California Code of Regulations, Title 5, Section 857(b)(11)] along with copies of the Summary Proficiency Level Reports.

Offset of State Mandated Costs: CELDT apportionment funds provided to districts shall first be used to offset any state-mandated reimbursable costs that otherwise may be claimed through the state mandates reimbursement process for the CELDT. Local education agencies accepting apportionment funds shall reduce their estimated and actual mandate reimbursement claims by the amount of funding provided to them from apportionment funds.

Enclosed is the 2007 Standardized Testing and Reporting (STAR) Program Apportionment Information Report for your district or charter school. This report includes the number tested by grade level for the California Standards Tests (CSTs) and California Achievement Tests, Sixth Edition Survey (CAT/6 Survey), California Alternate Performance Assessment (CAPA), Standards-based Tests in Spanish (STS), and Aprenda, La prueba de logros en español, Tercera edición (Aprenda 3). The California Department of Education (CDE) compiled the report from the information taken directly from students' multiple-choice answer documents. The STAR district and test site coordinators are responsible for inventory control and returning all test materials at the completion of testing to the contractor within the required time period (*California Code of Regulations*, Title 5, Education, Division 1, Chapter 2, Subchapter 3.75). **Do not** contact Educational Testing Service (ETS) or Harcourt Assessment, Inc. (Harcourt) with questions about the report or the data on it. The data on the Apportionment Information Report should agree with the student data files and summary reports that districts or charter schools received from ETS and Harcourt. Please note that STS and Aprenda 3 apportionment totals only reflect those students who were identified by demographic data as being English learners (ELs). Per state law, the STS and Aprenda 3 is to be administered only to Spanish-speaking ELs.

<u>Certification of Apportionment Information Report</u>: The superintendent or charter school administrator is required to certify the accuracy of the report, sign and date the report, and return it to:

Certified reports must be received postmarked by December 31, 2007. Certified reports will be processed for payment upon receipt. Payments will be processed through the State Controller's Office to county treasurers. If a district or charter school does not return a certified report to the CDE by the December 31, 2007, deadline, the district may apply for a waiver of the deadline to be approved by the State Board of Education (SBE) as provided by California Education Code Section 33050. The CDE cannot release payment of the apportionment funding for late reports without a waiver approved by the SBE. The specific waiver request form and instructions for state testing apportionments are available on the CDE Web site at http://www.cde.ca.gov/re/lr/wr/othertopics.asp. Payment of late apportionment reports is contingent upon the availability of an appropriation for this purpose in the fiscal year in which the tests were administered.

Charter Schools: Charter schools that tested independently of their district will receive individual apportionment information reports to certify and return to the CDE. Charter schools that had direct-funded status in 2006-07 will receive their STAR apportionment payment separately from the district. District apportionment totals will include apportionment funding for 2006-07 locally funded charters. The payment schedule provided to districts will include a listing of the amount locally funded charters are each to be apportioned.
