Complaints

BACKGROUND:

As per Education Code Section 35186, the Superintendent or designee shall report summarized data on the nature and resolution of all Williams Uniform Complaints on a quarterly basis to the Governing Board and the County Superintendent of Schools. The report shall include the number of complaints by general subject area with the number of resolved and unresolved complaints. These summaries shall be publicly reported on a quarterly basis at

a regularly scheduled Board Meeting.

DISCUSSION:

During the months of October, November, and December 2014, the District received a total of six (6) Williams Uniform Complaint.

There was (1) one complaint regarding a lack Textbooks and Instructional Materials; two (2) complaints regarding Teacher Vacancy or Misassignments; three (3) complaints regarding Unsafe Facilities Conditions; and zero (0) complaints concerning CAHSEE Intensive Instruction and Services. Five of the six complaints have been resolved and one is still pending.

Melrose Leadership Academy (Nov.)	1	Facilities – bad odor in the main office.	Yes	Resolved. Buildings and Grounds Dept. investigated and found a dead mouse stuck in the back of a small refrigerator; which has since been discarded. Area was cleaned and there is no longer a bad odor.
Howard Elementary (Nov.)	1	Facilities – Tiles in Room 9 were removed without notice to the teacher. Almost half of the tiles were taken out and left on the ground underneath exposed leaving a pungent odor.	Yes	Resolved. Buildings & Grounds staff replaced flooring throughout the school site and in Room 9 as well. Concerns have been addressed.
