**Subject** **Certification of Unhoused Pupils as Related to Charter School Applications for Facilities Funding**

**Action Requested** Adoption by the Board of Education of Resolution 1314-1115 – Authorizing and approving Certification of Unhouse Pupils Related to Charter School Applications for Facilities Funding in accordance with applicable law.

**Background** Pursuant to School Facility Program Regulation Section 1859.162. regarding General Preliminary Charter School Apportionment Eligibility Criteria, the Charter Schools listed below have or will submit an application for Charter Schools Facilities Funding to the Office of Public School Construction.

As a condition of processing a Charter School application for facilities funding under the Charter School Facilities Program (CSFP), a resolution is required from the Governing Board of the local school district in which the Charter School is physically located, certifying the number of projected unhoused pupils, if any, that will be served by the proposed Charter School project.

Pursuant to CSFP Regulation Section 1859.162.1(a) the Oakland Unified School District Board of Education is required to discuss this issue as an action item at a regularly scheduled board meeting.

The following proposed Charter School projects are anticipated to be physically located within the boundaries of the following High School Attendance Areas within the Oakland Unified School District:

<u>Proposed Charter Project</u>	<u>High School Attendance Area Location</u>
Aspire Maynard Academy Berkeley	Oakland HS/ Technical
Aspire ERES	Fremont

The Aspire Berkley Maynard Academy proposed project will provide facilities for an existing Charter School Program currently housed in an Oakland Unified School District facility. The Oakland/Oakland Technical Super High School Attendance Area at this time does not generate projected unhoused pupils that would be served by the proposed Charter School projects.

The Aspire ERES Academy proposed project plans to house 444 K-6 pupils. However, as 167 K-6 pupils are already housed at the site, this project is projected to serve an additional 277 K-6 projected unhoused pupils. Therefore, there are 277 unhoused K-6 pupils that would be served by the project.

The project plans to request 120 7-8 pupils. However, as 55 7-8 pupils are already housed at the site, this project is projected to serve an additional 65 7-8 pupils. Therefore there are 65 projected unhoused 7-8 pupils that would be served by the charter.

In summary, the following is the projected unhoused pupils that will be served by the proposed Charter School projects:

**WHEREAS**, the Charter Schools listed below have requested that the Oakland Unified School District Board of Education discuss and certify to the number of projected unhoused pupils, if any, that will be served by the proposed Charter School projects, pursuant to School Facility Program Regulation Section 1859.162.1(a); and

**WHEREAS**, a condition of processing the Charter School applications under the Charter School Facilities Program is a resolution from the Governing Board of Education of the School District in which the Charter School is physically located which certifies to the number of District projected unhoused pupils, if any, that will be served by the proposed Charter School project; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to School Facility Program Regulation Section 1859.162.1(a) the Oakland Unified School District Board of Education is required to discuss this issue as an action item at a regularly scheduled, publicly held board meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Charter School projects are anticipated to be physically located within the boundaries of the following High School Attendance Areas within the Oakland Unified School District:

**WHEREAS**, the Aspire Berkley Maynard Academy proposed project will provide facilities for an existing Charter School Program currently housed in an Oakland Unified School District facility; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to School Facility Program Regulation Section 1859.50, the Oakland/Oakland Technical Super High School Attendance Area at this time does not generate projected unhoused pupils that would be served by the proposed Charter School projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Aspire ERES Academy proposed project plans to house 444 K-6 pupils. However, as 167 K-6 pupils are already housed at the site, this project is projected to serve an additional 277 K-6 projected unhoused pupils. Therefore, there are 277 unhoused K-6 pupils that would be served by the project.

**WHEREAS**, the Aspire ERES Academy project plans to request 120 7-8 pupils. However, as 55 7-8 pupils are already housed at the site, this project is projected to serve an additional 65 7-8 pupils. Therefore there are 65 projected unhoused 7-8 pupils that would be served by the charter.

**WHEREAS**, Exhibits A-1 and A-2, attached, outline the methodology utilized to determine the number of unhoused pupils which would be served by each of the proposed projects.



The project plans to request 120 7-8 pupils. However, as 117 7-8 pupils are already housed at the site, this project is projected to serve an additional 3 7-8 pupils. However, based upon current eligibility calculations, the HSAA is able to house all of its 7-8 pupils. Therefore there are no projected unhoused 7-8 pupils that would be served by the charter.
