To have high-quality instruction in every classroom, the Oakland Unified School District must achieve the following strategic objectives:

- have a principal at every school who is an effective and strategic instructional and organizational leader;
- increase retention of committed, caring, and effective teachers at every school, especially in lowperforming schools with high teacher turnover;
- support every teacher with high quality professional development, mentoring, collaboration, and observation/feedback;
- create school program designs and organizational practices that enable teachers to personalize student learning;
- provide schools guided budget authority and opportunities for curricular flexibility;
- provide safe and supportive conditions that foster students' physical, emotional, and social readiness to learn;
- 7. provide school facilities and infrastructure that facilitate the delivery of high-quality instruction.

To achieve these strategic objectives, the Oakland Board of Education will:

- 1. hire and retain a Superintendent who is a proven leader in strengthening and improving classroom instruction:
- 2. establish strategic partnerships with community, labor, business, civic, education, philanthropic, and governmental leaders that help strengthen and improve classroom instruction;
- increase revenues, protect assets, and optimize the use of all available resources toward strengthening and improving classroom instruction;
- continuously monitor performance quality and performance impact in every classroom, every school, and every department.
