
Academic Data--ELA

Overall Placement






Academic Data--Math








BayTech ELD Population




ELD Student Population

BayTech: Areas for Improvement

Test Scores & Class Selections:

- BayTech needs to get back to the pre-shooting test scores in ELA. BayTech's focus needs to be on the continued implementation of its new all-school math curriculum (Carnagie Learning).
- BayTech needs to continue its college going culture by increasing our SAT & ACT scores. Currently, we score at the national average on the SAT and ACT, we need to be beyond.
- BayTech's College Pathways have just started and will need further refinement.
- BayTech needs to grow its offerings of higher- level math. Calculus A/B starts this fall.
