## RECOMMENDATION

Adoption by the Board of Education of Resolution No. 2021-0276 - Measure N - College and Career Readiness Commission - Education Improvement Plans and Budgets for District and Charter Schools – Administrative 10% - 2021-2022 School Year in the cumulative amount of \$11,987,571.30.

## OVERVIEW & OBJECTIVE

Twenty-six OUSD district schools and charter schools submitted their 2021-2022 Measure N Education Improvement Plan that articulates the pathway development work done to date, the pathway development work planned for the upcoming academic year, and a clear Measure N budget.

Linked Learning High School Office staff reviewed the 2021-2022 Measure N Education Improvement Plans and applied a framework that looked at primarily 3 variables:

1. Implementing all phases of Linked Learning in the school
2. Quality of the Analysis and Plan
3. Alignment of Budget to the overall plan and outcomes

Four schools were determined as “Probationary” during the final recommendations of the 2019-20 academic year. Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, and schools being shut down for in-person instruction, the Measure N Commission and Staff decided to postpone the intensive probationary review process in 2020-2021 and resume in Fall 2021. As a result, the four schools will remain on probationary status during the 2021-2022 academic year to continue the intensive support as they transition into the implementation process. The full Probationary review process will resume in the 2021-22 academic year after schools reopen for in-person instruction and school site visits are allowed. One new charter school submitted a Measure N planning grant application for 2021-2022. That school is part of Cohort 4.

The Measure N Commission, after due consideration of funding applications and staff recommendations, has approved Measure N recommendations as reflected in the attached documents.

**ADOPTING MEASURE N – COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS COMMISSION - EDUCATION IMPROVEMENT PLAN IMPLEMENTATION AND BUDGET – ADMINISTRATIVE 10% - 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR**

**WHEREAS**, the Oakland Unified School District (“District”) Board of Education by Resolution Nos. 2021-0276, has established, pursuant to the College and Career Readiness Act, the Measure N Commission, to oversee the Act including advising and reporting to the Board of Education and for (1) Planning, which includes (a) reviewing each high school's School Quality Review findings, and education improvement plans, and (b) submitting school funding recommendations to the Board of Education for action; and (2) Oversight, which includes (a) oversight of proper allocation and use of all parcel tax monies, (b) reviewing annual independent audit reports, and (c) submitting recommendations to the Board of Education for any new or modified policies and administrative regulations to ensure the Oakland Unified School District's compliance with the requirements and intent of this Measure; and

**WHEREAS**, the Measure N – College and Career Readiness Oversight Commission, in its sixth year of operation, at its Regular Meeting on May 4, 2021 and June 1, 2021, reviewed and affirmed its findings of named high schools’ implementation of Measure N to date and, consequently, determined and recommended Measure N Budget/Awards for the 2021-2022 School Year for each school named in attached Exhibit “A” as stated and hereby recommends approval of same by the Board of Education,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of Education hereby accepts and adopts the Measure N – College and Career Readiness - Oversight Commission Education Improvement Plan Implementation and Budget – 2021-2022 School Year to schools and Administrative 10% as delineated in attached Exhibit “A”; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board hereby authorizes the Secretary to annotate each school’s Legislative File No., listed in column 1, of Exhibit “A” of the Resolution, showing adoption of school’s Education Improvement Plan and Budget, by the Board (for purposes of full disclosure of the cumulative record of the transactions of the Measure N Commission and the Board, on each matter), as if each file were an individually Board adopted legislative file; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Board hereby approves and appropriates from the Measure N – College and Career Readiness Fund, as an Award, the stated 2021-2022 Funding for each named school.
