On February 21st 2013 ACC (All City Council) had their 7th High School General Meeting at Skyline High School. Among attendees were Ralph J. Bunch, CCPA, Fremont, Life, MetWest, Oakland High, and Skyline.

Delegates from Ralph J. Bunch report that their campus has had many improvements and so far there are no concerns or upcoming events.

Delegates from CCPA report that an improvement on their campus has been more student leading extracurricular activities. Some remaining concerns include the quality of the cafeteria food and the lack of foreign language classes. CCPA's leadership class has been currently working to construct a weight room and to start a group to address campus problems. Delegates from MetWest High School report that the bathrooms and cafeteria food need improvement. Remaining concerns include lack of space on campus, lack of support and the concern of students on who will be the principle for the upcoming year. Student leadership has been currently working on conducting a fishbowl on Social, Emotional, and Academic Student Support. There are no Upcoming events.

Delegates from Oakland High School report that an improvement has been the cafeteria food. A remaining concern are the bathrooms on campus. Student leadership has been working on the blood drive and multi-cultural week. Upcoming events include multi-cultural week.

Delegates from Skyline High School report that some improvements have been the budget, parent involvement and bathrooms. Skyline leadership has been working on most of the student events on campus and are trying to get voices heard but it's complicated to do so.
