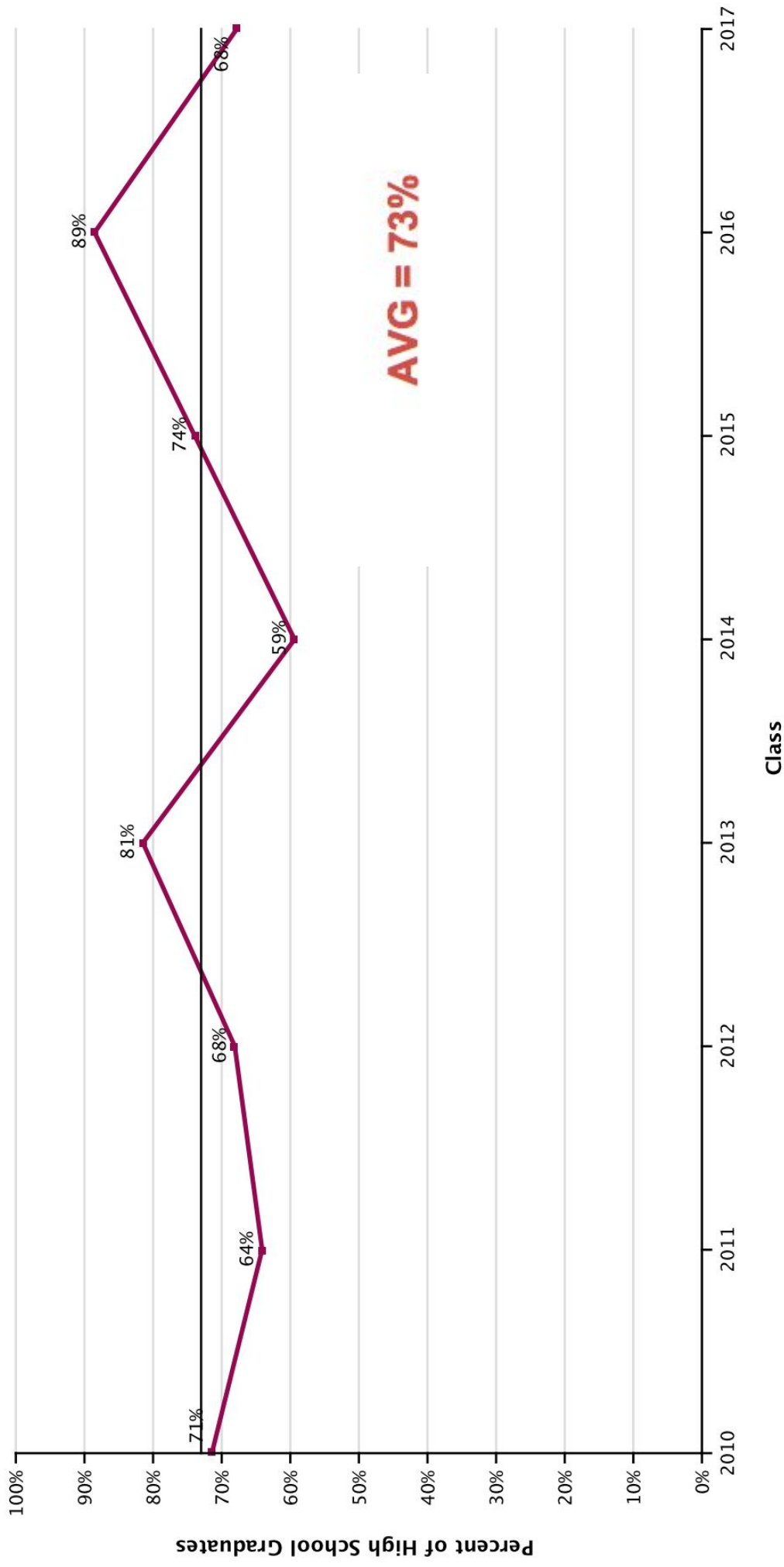

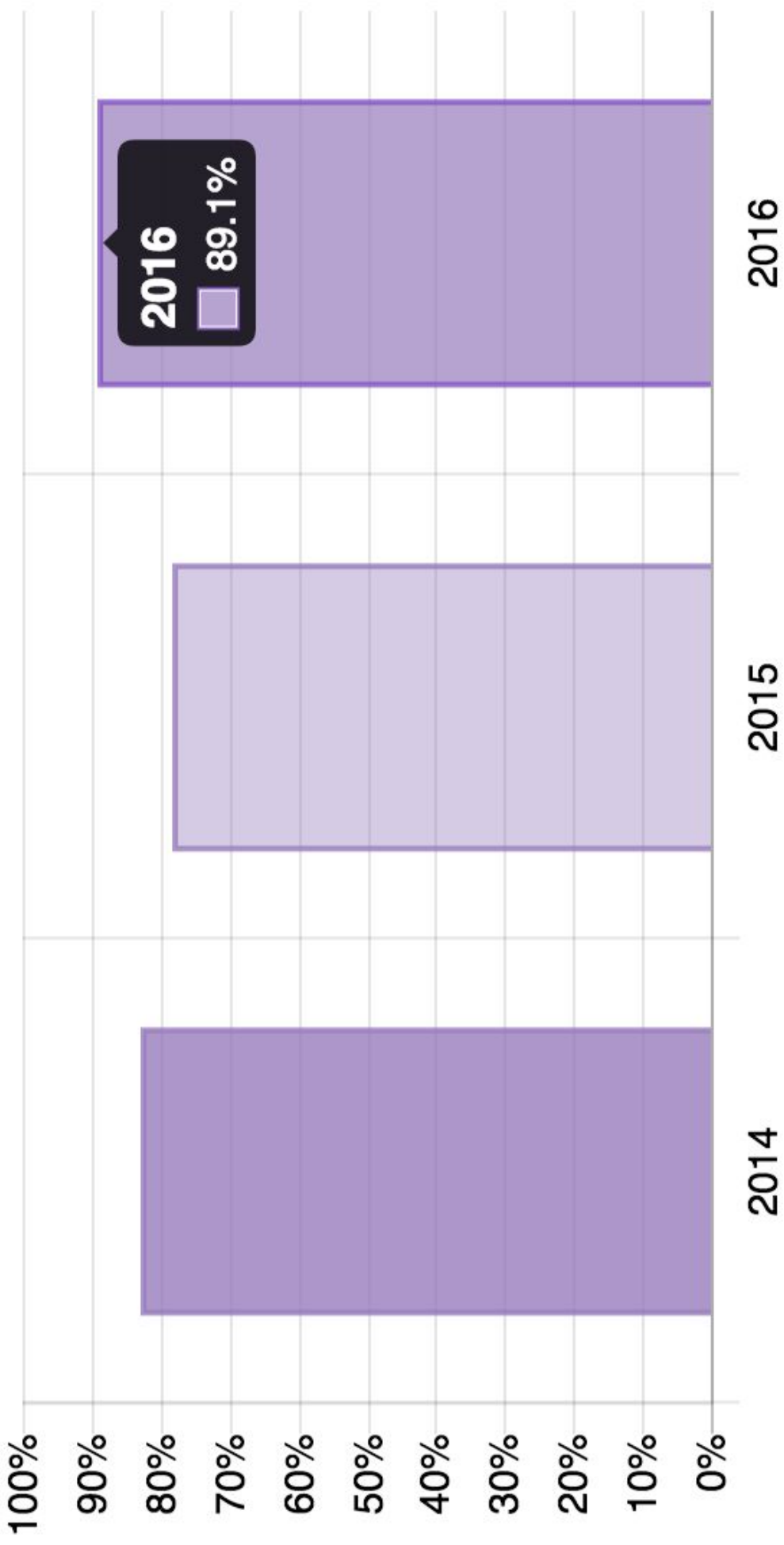
Percent of Students Enrolled in College at Any Time During the First Year After High School

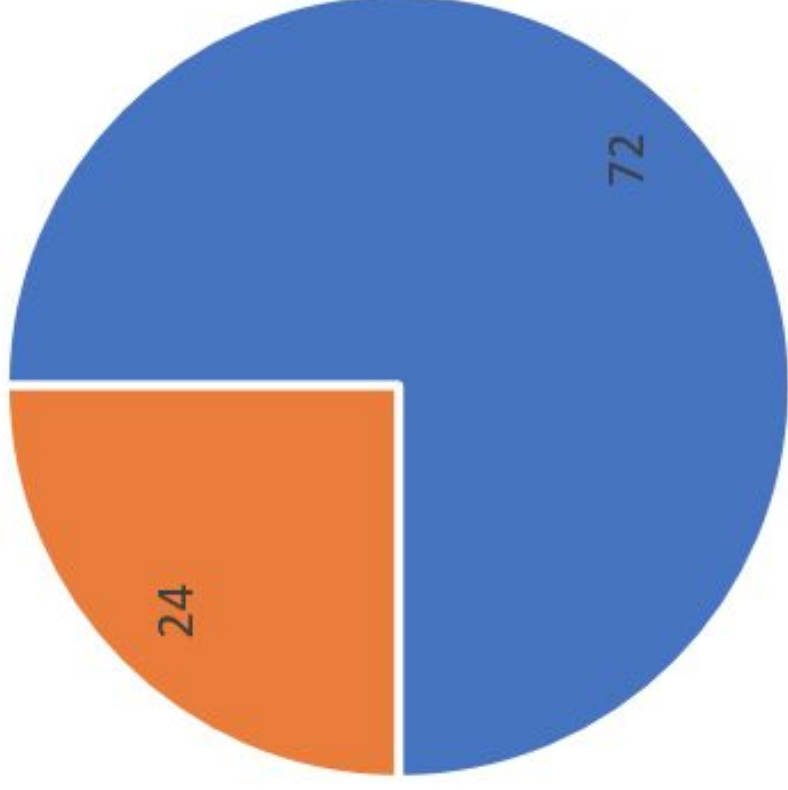

## Graduation



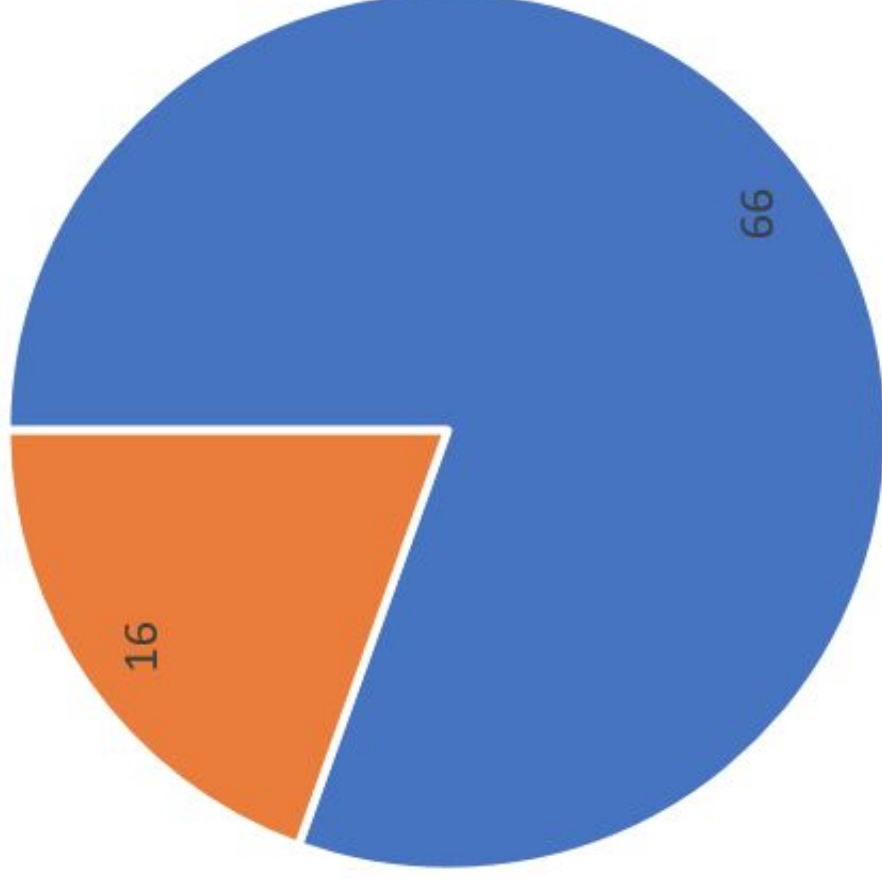
# On-Track/Off-Track Grade 10

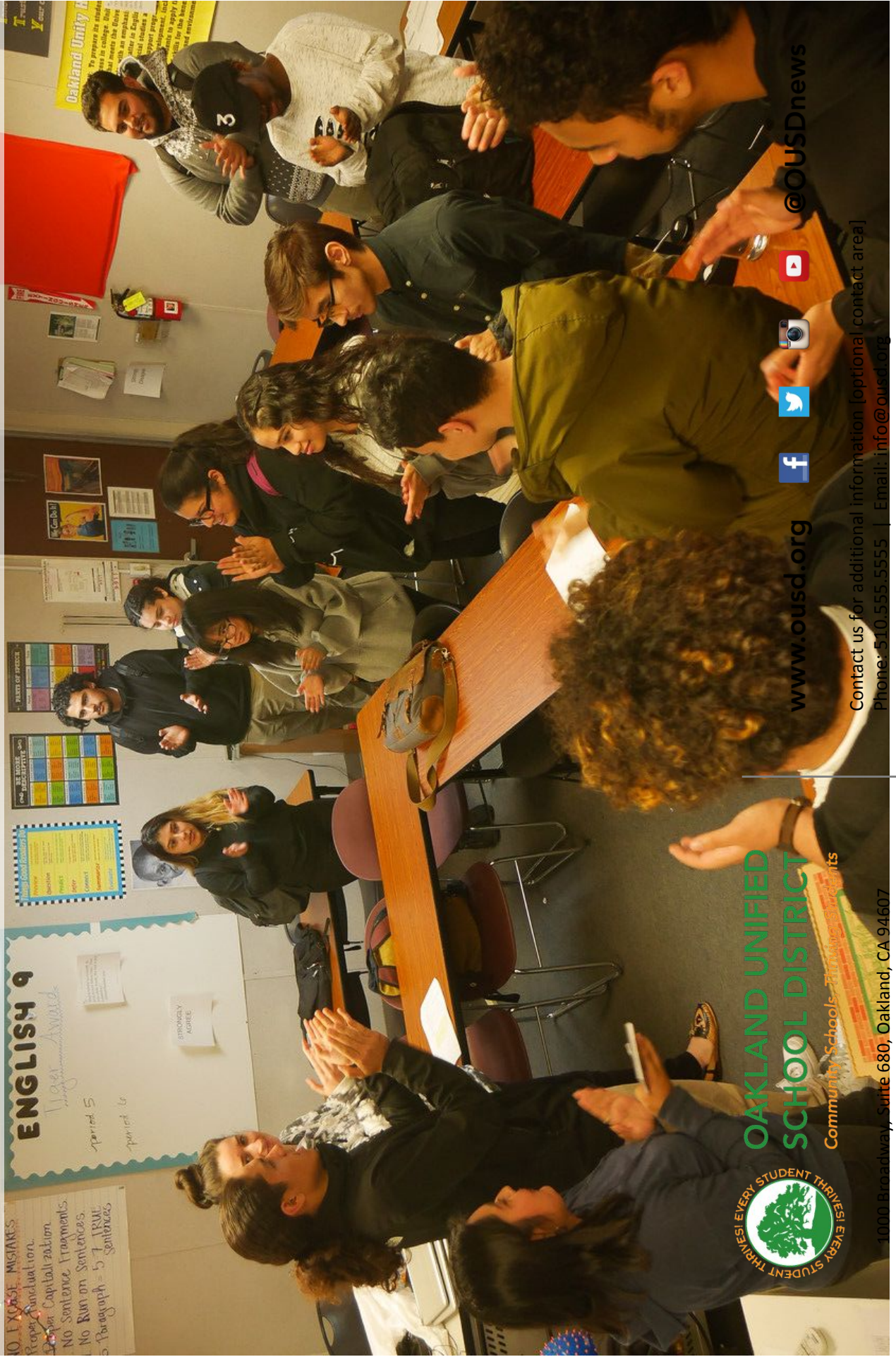

<b>Graduate Outcomes</b>	Increase college completion rate of Unity alumni to 40% by 2025 We will keep our graduation rate above 80% for the Class of 2017 and Class of 2018.
<b>Post-Secondary Readiness</b>	Increase college completion of Unity alumni to 40% by 2025 1) Alumni advocate position will increase database of alumni contacts and conduct surveys of alumni status. 2) Analysis of alumni data will be conducted to identify patterns and trends among college completion rates. 3) Alumni interviews will be conducted to find needed areas of increased focus and support during high school. 4) Summer Bridge program for 2017 seniors
<b>Climate and Culture</b>	Maintain suspensions under 3% while promoting strong academic identity and professional behavior expectations. 1) Grow school Wellness Program to address socio-emotional learning and needs 2) Pilot Student-Lead Conferences twice yearly to increase student and parent engagement in learning 3) Increase opportunities for positive recognition through Student of the Month program 4) Build parent engagement and school culture through relaunch of Spring Festival
<b>Rigorous Academics</b>	Increase performance on SBAC to 75% in English and 48% in Math 1) Academic Literacy Intervention to support EL and LTEL students in 9th grade to remove literacy barriers to content engagement 2) Double size of AP Calculus cohort. Increase math support so that all 9th and 10th graders are taking two sections of math. 3) Summer Academy provides intensive remediation in small group format for students off track to graduate
<b>Pathway Development</b>	Build 21st Century Skills pathway 1) Pilot Internship Program to allow Unity seniors to pursue authentic work-based learning opportunities 2) Project Based Learning Initiative to promote cross-curricular and real-world learning. 3) Career Exploration curriculum in Advisory at 11th grade
