ON-LINE SPEAKER CARD REGISTRATION

Public Comment, at the meeting, will be taken individually on Agenda Items indicated by microphone icon.

You may register to speak in advance on the Agenda Item whether attending the meeting by teleconference, e.g., Zoom, or in person. On line Speaker Card Registration (Sign In To Speak) opens at minimum 72 hours in advance for a Regular Meeting or at minimum 24 hours in advance for a Special Meeting.

Use the eComment Link to Sign In (Register) to Speak up to one hour before the beginning of the meeting. Manual (Paper) Speaker Cards also will be available at the meeting for completion.

Sign In to Speak, on an eligible Agenda Item, as a matter of equity, is first registered, first called, in order of Registration whether participation is in person or virtually, e.g. Zoom, or by audio, e.g., telephone. For advanced pre-meeting Registration, You must establish a one-time OUSD eComment - Sign In (Register) To Speak Account providing your First Name and Last Name and your email address.
