- A Full-Service Community School
- Serves 18 – 24 year old disconnected youth
- High School Diploma and Job Training Program
- Founded in 1983 as East Bay Conservation Corps
- Original Charter granted in 1995
- 1:19 teacher to student ratio
- Alternative Schools Accountability Model (ASAM) school since 2005

Student Figures



- 97% are eligible for free/reduced lunch
- 30% are parents
- 30% are homeless or have unstable housing
- 31% are involved with the juvenile or adult justice system
- 32% are emancipated foster care youth
- 14% have current IEP's or 504 Plans

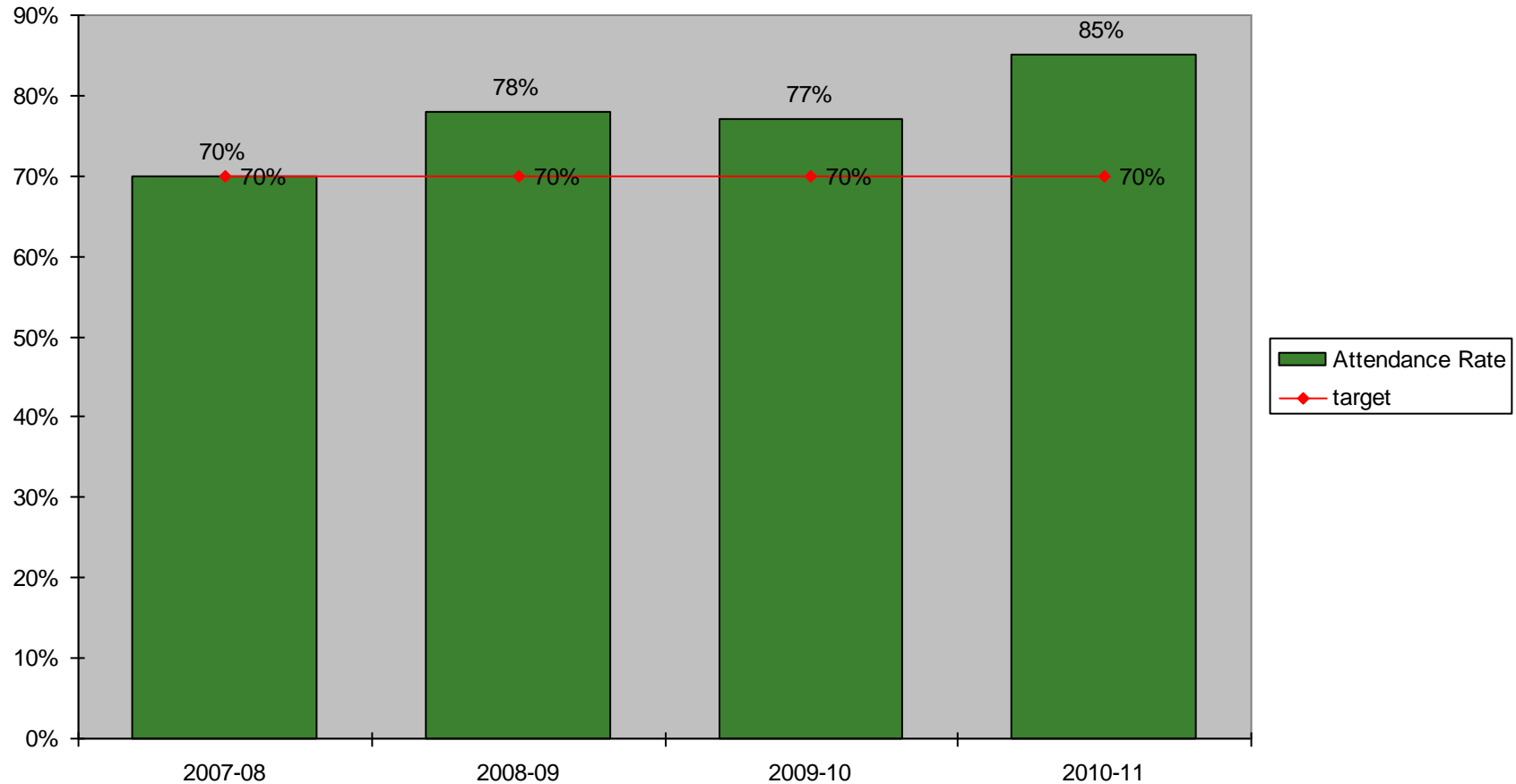


Serving approximately 200 students each year

- 36% Female

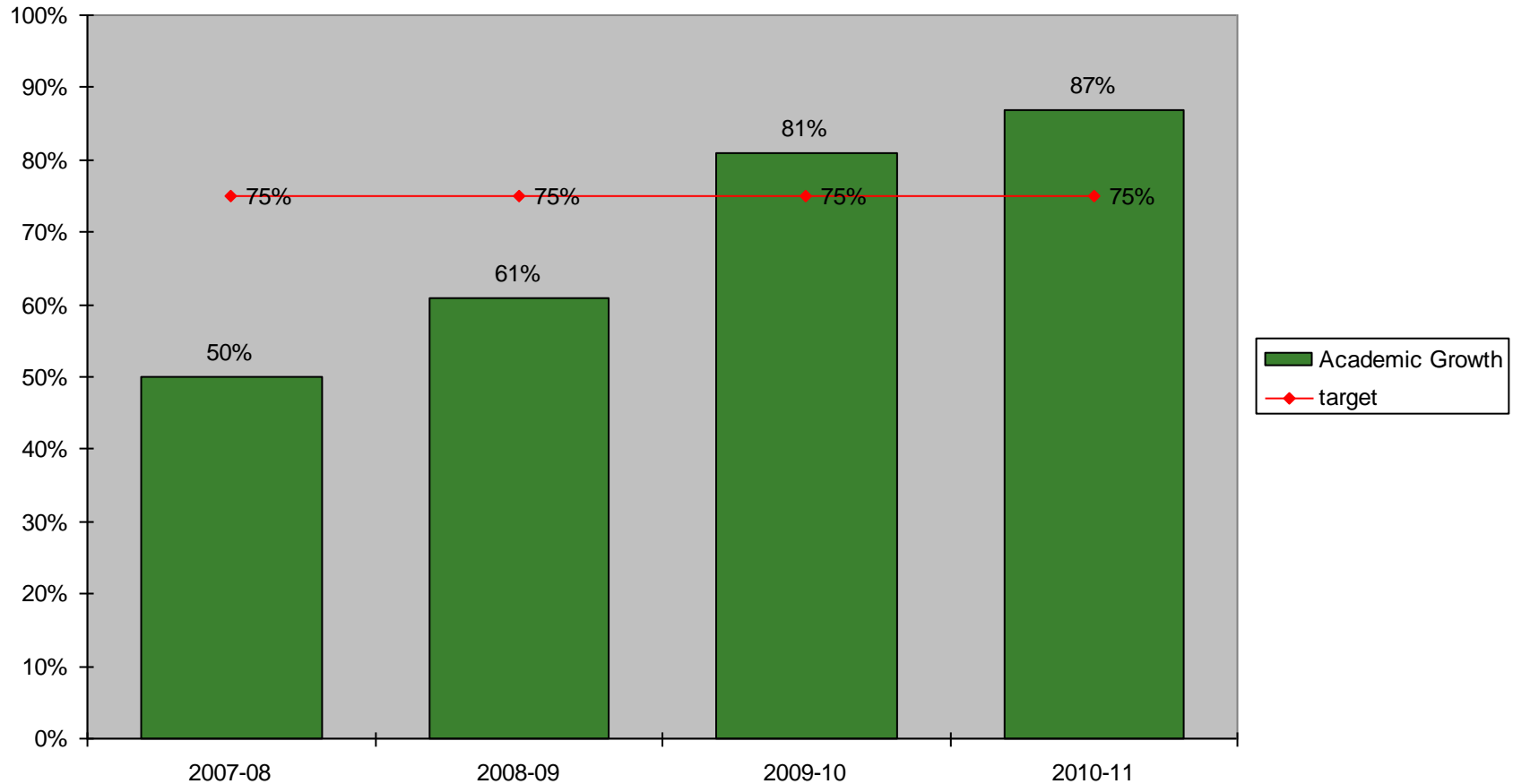
Measurable Pupil Outcome

Attendance Rate



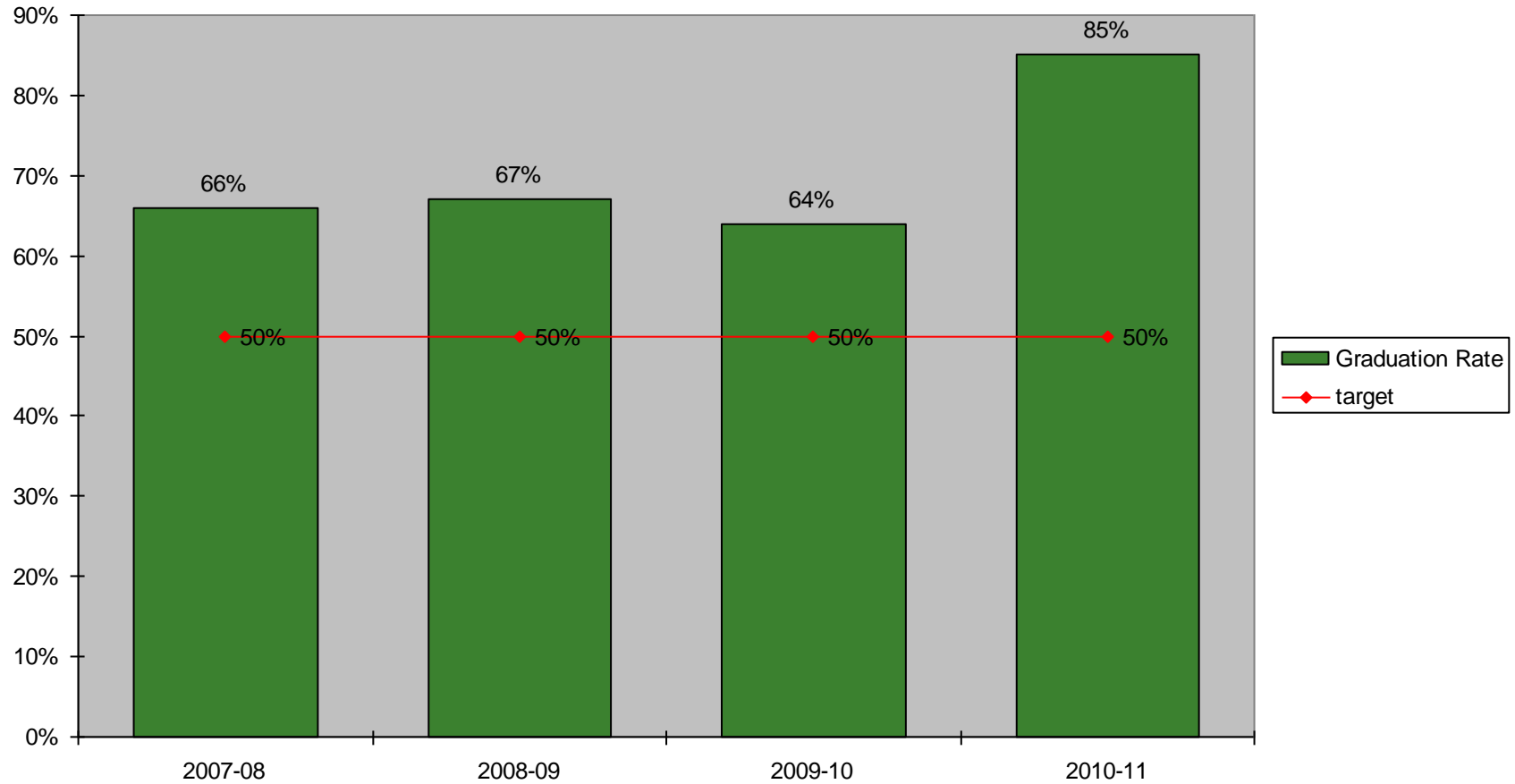
Measurable Pupil Outcome

- Portfolio based requirements for graduation
 - Passage of CAHSEE and NWEA
 - Rigor, Critical Thinking, Applied Knowledge
 - Requirements Include:
 - 5-page research paper on a community issue
 - Public speaking
 - Portfolio presentation
 - Core content (Science, Math, English, Social Studies, Electives)
 - College and Career Exploration assignments
 - Multi-media presentations
 - Community Service and Democratic Participation

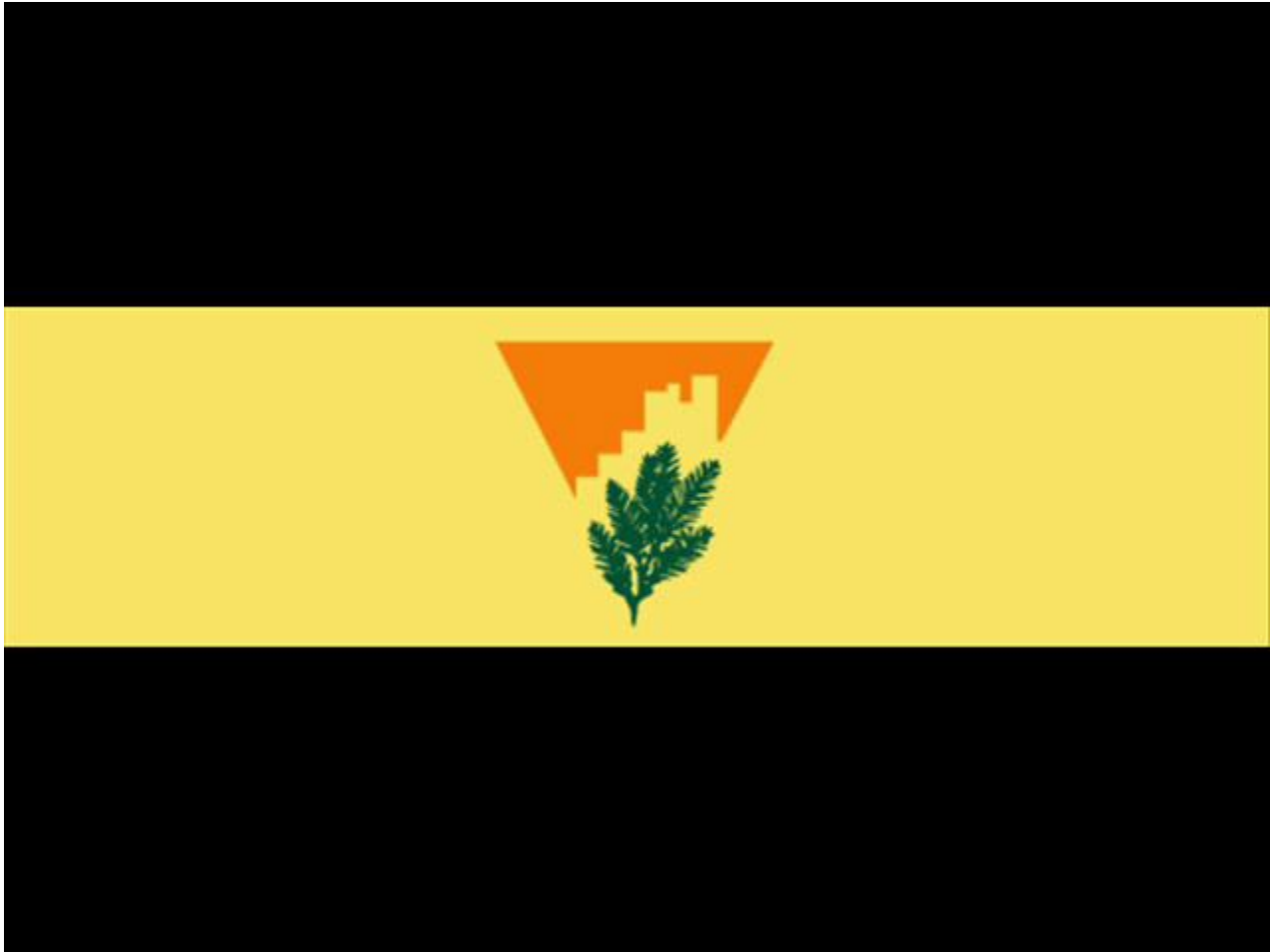
- Full-time support services team
 - Resource Specialist
 - Serves 100% of students with IEP's or 504 Plans
 - Case Counselor
 - Serves 100% of students through group education and support sessions
 - Engages in 500+ hours of individual counseling each year
 - College/Career Counselor
 - Serves 100% of students through skills workshops
 - Serves 100% of graduates with job and career transition
