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Highlights: Street Academy



- Partnership with Holy Names University to help get in the pipeline and recruit more teachers of color into Oakland Public School classrooms
- This school year during distance learning students have gotten the opportunity to partner with Holy Names University Professors by virtually leading Dynamic Mindfulness/ Transformative Life Skills
- Also spoken at town hall meetings to incoming teachers about their experience with distance learning and how teachers can connect better with urban youth

Highlights: Fremont High School



- Fremont had 42 students from the Media and Architecture Academies participate in internships and Laney classes this summer, despite the pandemic.
- 17 of 42 interns were part of the Media Academy Summer Institute, run by Media CTE Teachers. Students focused on graphic design, audio, and video production. Their work was featured in the <u>Fruitvale Short Film</u> <u>Festival</u> in September.
- Architecture Academy has also been instrumental in <u>Oakland Manufacturing Week</u>, with Construction CTE Teacher Drew Prober providing a tour of EBY Construction, where he used to work in the industry.
- Construction of the new <u>Media and Architecture CTE classrooms</u> is nearing completion, courtesy of Measure J Facilities Bond. Expected completion date is December 2020.

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Carryover Changes



- 3 of the 5 small schools have decreased their carryover amount since last year
- 3 of the 6 multiple pathway schools have decreased their carryover amount since last year
- 1 of the 7 Alt Ed schools have decreased their carryover amount since last year
- 3 of the 9 charter schools have decreased their carryover amount since last year






Appendix: 2015-2020 Measure N Carryover Overview
