BACKGROUND:

As per Education Code Section 35186, the Superintendent or designee shall report summarized data on the nature and resolution of all Williams Uniform Complaints on a quarterly basis to the Governing Board and the County Superintendent of Schools. The report shall include the number of complaints by general subject area with the number of resolved and unresolved complaints. These summaries shall be publicly reported on a quarterly basis at a

regularly scheduled Board Meeting.

DISCUSSION:

During the months of April, May and June 2014, the District received a total of six (6) Williams Uniform Complaints. There were (2) complaints regarding a lack Textbooks and Instructional Materials; zero (0) complaints regarding Teacher Vacancy or Misassignment; four (4) complaints regarding Facilities conditions; and zero (0) complaints concerning CAHSEE Intensive Instruction and Services. Only one complaint regarding instructional materials is pending.
