Background:

The adoption is an opportunity to:

- support our Chinese world language teachers in adopting new materials; and
- update our current materials that focus on Chinese culture and history with more modern materials that meet the needs of students who want to have daily conversations, read, and write Chinese.

Selection Process

- Piloting: our two current Chinese world language teachers piloted a unit of Cheng and Tsui's Integrated Chinese in the fall of 2024;
- Additional stakeholder input: Feedback from students and families; and
- **Deliberation:** The final deliberation brought together piloting teachers using a common rubric.

Strengths

- Cheng and Tsui, Co., Inc.
 - Has good lay out and display of information;
 - Easy to to read and understand;
 - AP students can use level 2 of the new materials;
 - Diverse materials: book, online resources, video recordings for student to listen to dialog and see the visuals. Online resources students can use.;
 - Good written assessments:
 - Language practice, using the vocabulary and sentence structures daily conversations; and
 - Useful language practice, sentences replicate common on the street every day Chinese

Feedback

Students said:

- Most students are taking Chinese to learn how to have basic conversations and to learn to read and write;
- Most said they appreciated the new materials for:
 - "I liked the resources and support around Chinese characters, vocabulary, and sentence writing."
 - "I liked the layout of the new textbook. I found it easier to read and understand."
- One student shared:
 - "My Chinese teacher is great and I enjoy taking Chinese classes. I think the Chinese textbooks are also very good and suitable for most students to understand."
- One student shared:
 - "This year, I have been learning a lot of new vocabulary and gaining more comfort speaking mandarin. I believe that the increased use of the language in my AP class has helped improve my skills substantially."






