All City Council Student Union Governing Board (ACC) is eager to share with you all what we have been up to. We have been preparing for our upcoming All City Council High School Kick Off Retreat. We are actively developing our leadership skills in order to strengthen activities that will take place. The retreat will offer intentional training for students on Meaningful Student Engagement and how to promote student voice and power in decision making spaces. ACC Members have been reaching out to leadership bodies at our various schools and other affinity groups like the Black Student Union or Latinos Unidos in order to ensure an equitable representation of students.

We would also like to uplift and appreciate all students who were at the last Board Meeting and advocated passionately about the Supper Program. It was truly empowering to see student leaders being a champion for themselves and all other students in our district. We invite all students to attend the Board Meetings and participate in learning and speaking on the various topics that are discussed related to our education here in OUSD. We are here to remind all of us of the power in a student voice.

Our first High School Meeting for the year will be take place on October 19-20th, making our ACC High School Kick Off Retreat. Here, we will understand the role and impact of student leadership in OUSD. Students will have an opportunity to build across school sites, receive training on representative leadership, analyze OUSD student data, and identify their focus for this school year. We will also be engaging our peers in a process to help inform OUSD budget recommendations by students and for students. Students will meet with youth leaders from all over Oakland who are passionate to improve our schools and community. They will learn about different community initiatives and campaigns, and elect the 2018-2019 ACC LCAP Student Budget Directors. We are also excited to announce that an advisory committee of students to guide our LGBTQ programming and policy in OUSD will begin. This student group will meet monthly at 1000 Broadway and will support and advise the important work of creating safe and supportive environments for LGBTQ students in the Oakland Unified School District. There is a stipend of \$250 available for their participation during the 2018-2019 school year. The deadline to apply is October 12th and it is only open to high school students.
