- Contracted Math Coach providing teachers with weekly support
- OCR 2002: All teachers except 2 have received training. They will participate in the next district sponsored training
- Regret that Glenview had to be SAIT monitored in order to receive funds to support its improvement. Additional support from the district is still needed; district support in securing a facilitator is welcomed
