I urge you to support the intent and focus of the Call for Quality Schools to improve our lowest performing schools. The status quo is unacceptable. The five Intensive Support Schools serve 2,000 low-income students, a majority of whom cannot read at grade level and will not graduate ready for college or career.

This is a complex process, and will need to be adjusted based on school community contexts. These schools have been through many changes. The most important outcome now is that our students receive a great education. We all share that responsibility.

I write to support your leadership in four areas:

1) Teachers deserve the biggest possible raise. Oakland teachers are among the lowest paid in the country. Teacher turnover harms our students. Let's take the necessary steps to conclude the contract negotiations quickly so that educators can focus on the difficult work of teaching.

2) Schools deserve intensive support for bold transformation when they are struggling. Low-performing schools need the best leadership, experience, and designs available. We should consider every strong option for children and families, both district-run and charter school models. More details need to be presented to the community, but the direction is right.

3) School communities deserve a say in the decisions that matter to their students' success. The power to make decisions about budgeting, staffing, curriculum, and time begins in this process. Families should fully participate in the transformation of their schools. To do so, they need accurate and timely information about successful school models and opportunities to shape a process that works for all.

4) We all deserve respectful communication and dialogue. Dramatic change often arouses strong emotions. But the level of misinformation, disruption, and disrespect from some in the education community is unacceptable. The NAACP has written a letter condemning the shocking conduct toward the superintendent. I urge you to stay strong and continue to create space for dialogue in this process.
