Subject **Granting One-Time Waiver of the 270 Day Requirement for Aspire ERES Academy - Charter Petition and Proposed Charter (Renewal) Submission**

Action Requested Approval of the Board Resolution 1819-0108 - Granting One-Time Waiver of the 270 Day Requirement for **Aspire ERES Academy** - Charter Petition and Proposed Charter (Renewal) Submission - Set Forth in Board Policy 0420.4 and Administrative Regulation 0420.4.

Background The Board of Education adopted District Board Policy (BP) 0420.4 and Administrative Regulation (AR) 0420.4 on or around August 25, 2004 to govern the charter petition renewal process. Both BP 0420.4 and AR 0420.4 provide that "The Board will accept a request to renew a charter at any regular Board meeting that is not prior to 270 days from the expiration of the charter."

For the 2018-2019 school year, the District has received seven (7) charter petition renewals. Specifically, the District has received renewal petitions from the following District-authorized charter schools:

1. Aspire ERES Academy
2. Aspire Monarch Academy
3. Aspire Triumph Technology Academy
4. Downtown Charter Academy
5. East Bay Innovation Academy
6. Epic Charter Academy
7. Oakland Military Institute College Preparatory Academy



Discussion

The Board, at its September 26, 2018 Regular Meeting, having received a request for waiver and presentation of the Epic Charter Renewal Petition and Proposed Charter at its September 12, 2018 Regular Meeting, granted EPIC a one-time waiver of the above-referenced "not prior to 270 days from the expiration of the charter" filing requirement.

At the September 26, 2018, Board Meeting, each of the other six schools named in this memo, presented their respective petition and charter renewal and requested a waiver of the "not prior to" filing requirement.

WHEREAS, Board Policy 0420.4 and Administrative Regulation 0420.4 provide that the "The Board will accept a request to renew a charter at any regular Board meeting that is not prior to 270 days from the expiration of the charter"; and

WHEREAS, the following charter petitions expire on June 30, 2019: (1) Aspire ERES Academy; (2) Aspire Monarch Academy; (3) Aspire Triumph Technology Academy; (4) Downtown Charter Academy; (5) East Bay Innovation Academy; (6) Epic Charter Academy; and (7) Oakland Military Institute College Preparatory Academy; and

WHEREAS, at the September 26, 2018, Board Meeting, **Aspire ERES Academy** submitted its charter renewal petition and requested the Board to waive the timelines set forth in Board Policy 0420.4;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of the District hereby agrees and resolves to grant the waiver request of **Aspire ERES Academy** on a one-time, non-precedential basis;
