The Engineering Academy's mission is to be innovative and rigorous with a project-based curriculum that will prepare students for careers in all STEM fields while providing them access to laboratory and internship experiences. This trip aligns with this mission and also our Graduate goals of career and community readiness. Learning about sustainability in terms of resource conservation and from industry/government officials supports our students in careers in STEM. This trip supports and enhances concepts of sustainability, conservation, career exploration, and environmentalism, all covered in the AP Environmental Science curriculum, which is a part of the course of study in Oakland Tech's Engineering Program. The nexus between the Slide Ranch and the Engineering Pathway is sustainable design concepts and conservation (they design ADU projects focused on sustainability in their CTE courses). In other words, this trip provides engineering context, insight, and application that can not be replicated in the classroom. Students will experience the application of engineering principles in the real world. In our Pathway meetings, our CTE teacher declared that of all the Engineering fields, Oakland Technical High School will be most in line with Technology Engineering, emphasizing sustainability. These themes and practices align with AP Environmental Science (APES) concepts. Fifty students in grades 11 and 12 will be allowed to attend this APES field trip. materials sustainability, building infrastructure design, environmental engineering, agriculture, and natural resource conservation. Students will visit the working farm, garden, chicken coop, and campsite.
