Background Pursuant to School Facility Program Regulation Section 1859.162. regarding

General Preliminary Charter School Apportionment Eligibility Criteria, the Charter

Schools listed below have or will submit an application for Charter Schools

Facilities Funding to the Office of Public School Construction.

As a condition of processing a Charter School application for facilities funding under the Charter School Facilities Program (CSFP), a resolution is required from the Governing Board of the local school district in which the Charter School is physically located, certifying the number of projected unhoused pupils, if any, that will be served by the proposed Charter School project.

Pursuant to CSFP Regulation Section 1859.162.1(a) the Oakland Unified School District Board of Education is required to discuss this issue as an action item at a regularly scheduled board meeting.
