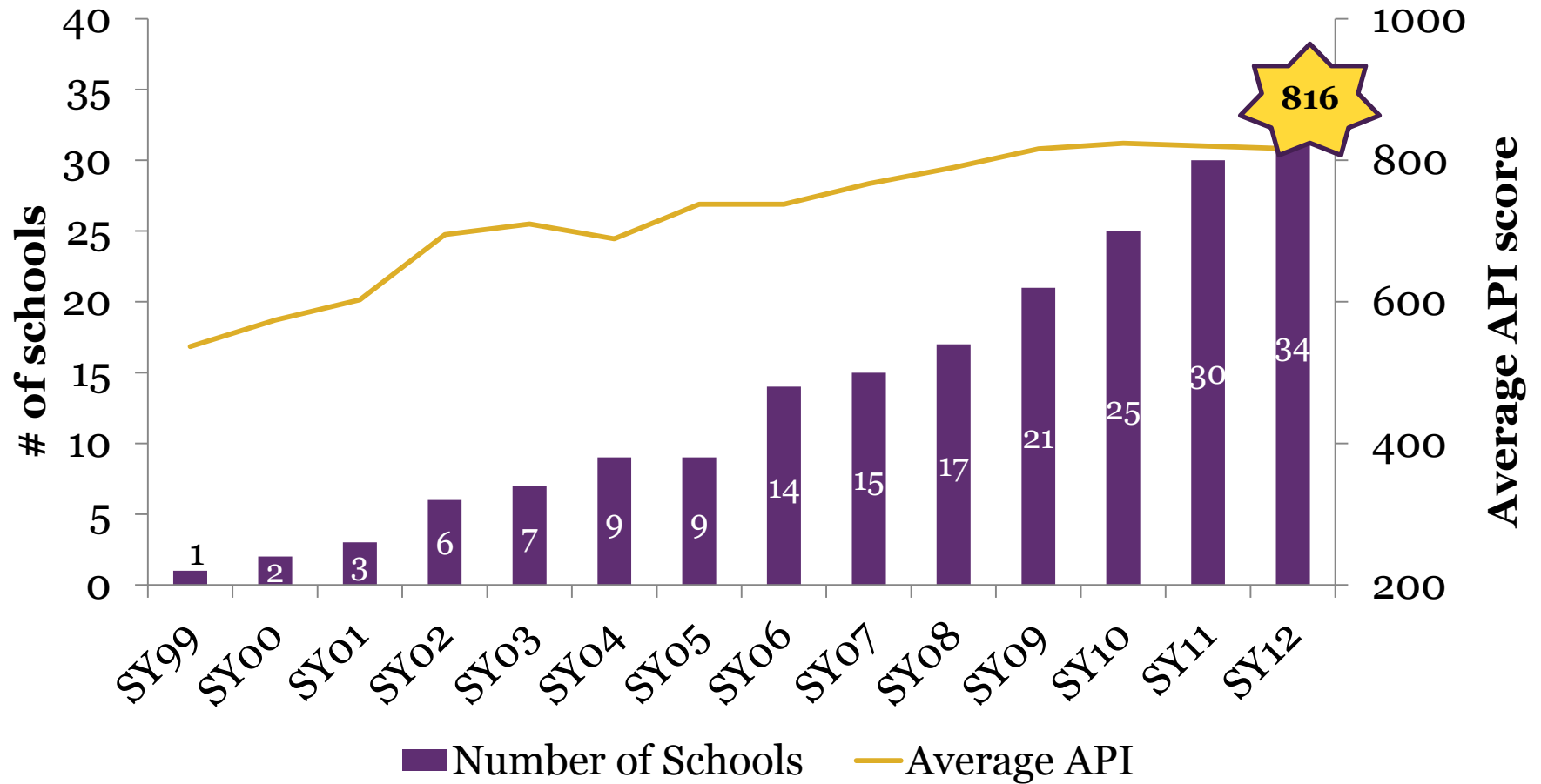

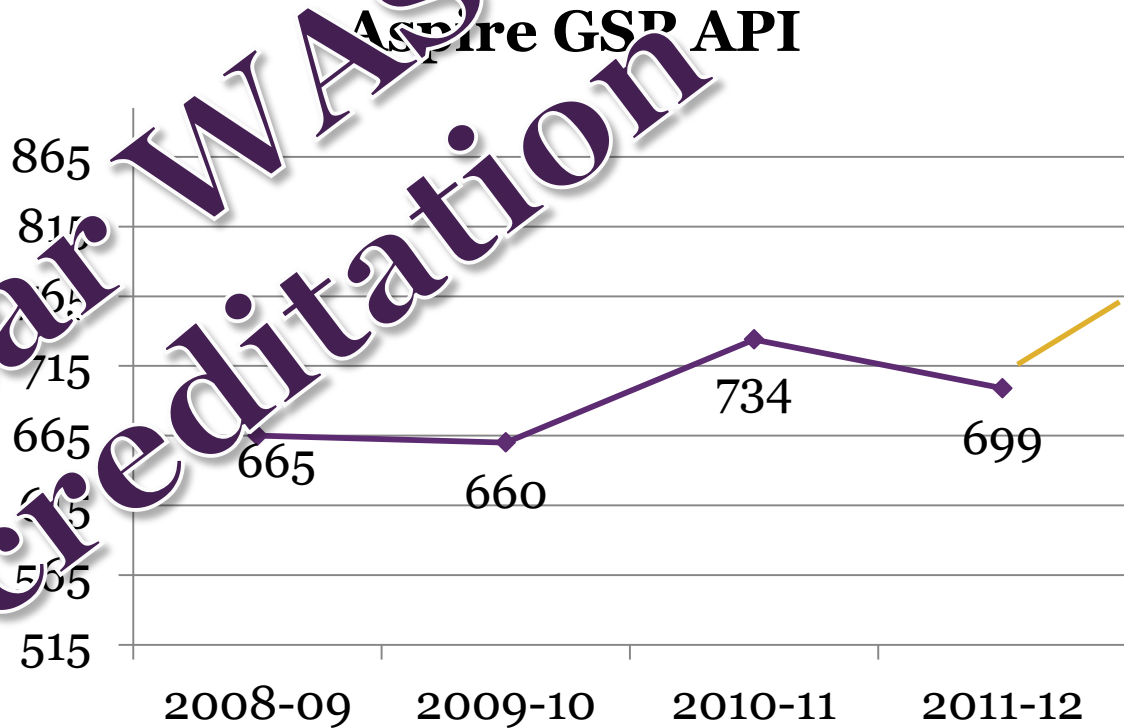
Program Highlights
