Action Requested **Amendment to Board of Education of Resolution 1314-1162 -- Certification of Unhoused Pupils as Related to OMI Charter School Application for Facilities Funding**

Background Under the Charter School Facility Program Regulation Section 1859.162 regarding preliminary charter school apportionment eligibility, Oakland Military Institute ("OMI") has or will submit an application for Charter Schools Facilities Funding to the Office of Public School Construction. As provided in Regulation Section 1859.162.1(a), the Board of Education at the June 25, 2014 meeting certified the number of unhoused students in the applicable attendance area of the proposed construction. The District subsequently learned that the Resolution 1314-1162, as originally approved by the Board of Education, erroneously included the Fremont High School Attendance Area. The purpose of this amendment is to delete the reference to the Fremont attendance area and to include only the McClymonds Attendance Area.

Application for Charter School Preliminary Apportionment

Dear Mr. White,

I am writing to notify the Oakland Unified School District (OSUD) and its Governing Board of Education that the Oakland Military Institute, College Prep. Academy (OMI) intends to file an application for new construction funding with the Office of Public School Construction (OPSC) under the Charter School Facilities Program as provided under Article 12, Chapter 12, Part 10, Division 1, Title 2 commencing with Section 17078.50 et. Seq., of the Education Code. As required by the OPSC, this notice has been sent to you by overnight mail.

OMI is required to notify the district superintendent and governing board of education of the school district in which the charter school project will be located at least thirty (30) days prior to certification and submittal of an SAB 50-09 *Application for Charter School Preliminary Apportionment* form to the OPSC. The deadline to file an SAB 50-09 form with the OPSC is May 30th, 2014. OMI intends to file an SAB 50-09 for its project which will include a request for up to 300 pupil grants.

As part of the application process, the school district in which the charter school will be physically located and where the new construction eligibility is assessed is required to submit a current SAB 50-01 *Enrollment Certification /Projection* form including any applicable charter school enrollment with the OPSC for the 2013/2014 CBEDS year. Therefore, I respectfully request that the OUSD file an updated SAB 50-01 form with the OPSC for the 2013/2014 school year prior to May 30th, 2014, if not already completed.

In addition, a school board resolution certifying to the number of the district's un-housed pupils, pursuant to Section 1859.162.1(a) that the project will house, the supporting documentation used to generate this number and the school board meeting minutes that recorded the approval of the certification is needed to complete the funding application. I respectfully request that these items be generated by district staff, approved by the school board and sent to OMI for inclusion in the funding application.

At your earliest convenience, please forward an updated SAB 50-01 *Enrollment Certification /Projection* form, school board resolution and supporting documentation, and tracking number for this project to OMI and the OPSC for inclusion as part of the SAB 50-09 *Application for Charter School Preliminary Apportionment* funding application. We would appreciate receiving these items on or before May 23rd, 2014 in order to present a complete funding application.
