#### DISTRICT BUDGET PRIORITIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013-2014

(Introduced by Board Directors Christopher Dobbins and David Kakishiba)

WHEREAS, the Oakland Unified School District as a K-12 public entity is required to adopt an annual balanced budget pursuant to the requirements of Education Code Section 42127, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board adopted the District's Five Year Plan - Community Schools, Thriving Students - May 2011 - May 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Board adopted a Balanced Scorecard to assess the progress and impact of the District's Five Year Plan - Community Schools, Thriving Students - May 2011 - May 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board has begun the budget development process for Fiscal Year 2013-2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Board in relation to the foregoing desires to set several funding priorities, among others, for Fiscal Year 2013-2014 and beyond,

**NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Governing Board hereby determines, and directs the Superintendent of Schools to develop and propose for the Board's adoption, in the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Budget, spending priorities that achieve the following Balanced Scorecard outcomes:

- 1. Increase Cohort Graduation Rates
- 2. Increase number and percentage of students meeting A-G Requirements upon graduation.
- 3. Increase number and percentage of 11<sup>th</sup> graders college readiness, as indicated by the California State University Early Assessment Program.
- 4. Increase number and percentage of students who have completed an academy or career pathway program upon graduation.
- 5. Increase number and percentage of students meeting A-G Requirements at the end of their 9<sup>th</sup> grade, 10<sup>th</sup> grade, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade years.
- 6. Decrease number and percentage of students who are chronically absent from school.
- 7. Increase number and percentage of students who attend school 95% or more days in a school year.
- 8. Increase number and percentage of students who attend an OUSD school for their 6<sup>th</sup> grade.
- 9. Decrease number and percentage of students who are suspended from school.
- 10. Decrease number and percentage of students who receive out-of-class discipline referrals.
- 11. Increase number and percentage of teachers demonstrating growth in pedagogical knowledge, expertise, and effectiveness.
- 12. Increase number and percentage of teachers indicating satisfaction with the relevance, quality, and personal engagement with school and district-based professional development, collaboration, and coaching.
- 13. Increase number and percentage of teachers retained after their 5<sup>th</sup> year of employment.
- 14. Increase number and percentage of schools assessed as a high-quality full-service community school.
- 15. Increase number and percentage of schools demonstrating growth in school quality standards.
- 16. On-going revenues are equal to or exceed on-going expenses.
- 17. Funding is allocated to practices and programs that achieve positive outcomes.
- 18. Funding to schools is equitably distributed based on the different student needs and life circumstances.
