TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT ON WEDNESDAY, October 9, 2013, at a Regular Meeting of the Governing Board ("Board") of the Oakland Unified School District, the Board will hold a public hearing on the District's Sufficiency of Textbooks and Instructional Materials-School Year 2013-2014.

 - (i) Mathematics.
 - (ii) Science.
 - (iii) History-social science.
 - (iv) English language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program; and
- consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the state board [of education] for foreign language or health course(s).
- And sufficiency of laboratory science equipment . . . applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 to 12, inclusive.

Parents, teachers, members of the community interested in the affairs of the school district, and bargaining unit leaders are urged to participate in the hearing.
